HOW TO OPERATE YOUR TRANSCEIVER

- Remove screw and open battery door and snap in a 9-volt battery. (Alkaline batteries recommended)
- Turn the "ON-OFF" switch to "ON" position. Your transceiver is now ready to operate.
- 3. Press the "PUSH TO TALK" button for transmitting.
- 4. Release "PUSH TO TALK" button for receiving.
- When transmitting, speak clearly in a normal voice, holding the set about 3" from your mouth.
- Best transmission and reception are obtained when the antenna is held in a vertical position.
- Operation range up to 200 feet, line of sight, in open area without obstruction & Interference.

HOW TO USE MORSE CODE FUNCTION

- For transmitting a signal, turn the "ON-OFF" switch to "ON" position.
- While pushing the push to talk button, press the morse code button momentarily and release for desired signal.
- And for receiving a signal, release the "PUSH TO TALK" switch.
- When back to communications again, use normal push to talk operation.

CAUTION

- Your transceiver set has been fully adjusted prior to shipment from the factory and be sure not to touch the internal components other than battery.
- When the sound becomes weak, it is time to change the Battery.
- After use, always return the ON-OFF Switch to the OFF position.
- 4. Keep your set in dry and clean place.
