
Helmet Speaker TR-HS001

User Manual




IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTION




3. Button Functions

4. Interface Description




- 1). Power switch ON/OFF

Charging instructions:


Charging	Insert power cord to charge.
	Red light indicates that unit is charging.
	Red light turns off when fully charged.
	Do not charge for more than 4 hours even if red
	light stays on.
	Unplug power cord once charging is complete.
Play time	More than 4 hours at 80% volume.

6. Pairing

Turn on power then search for "helmet speaker" on your device. If your device requests a pairing code, enter "0000". This speaker only supports one device pairing at a time so disconnect your other devices before attempting to pair.
