Using the Stunt granny

Switch on the granny (switch is on the bottom) and the controller (see diagram).

This item works via radio control. Be sure to be pointing the antenna of the controller in the general direction of

Use the joystick on the controller to move the stunt granny in the desired direction. The stunt granny also has a TURBO button for forward movements. Press this button in conjunction with the direction keys for extra speed and to flip her onto her back wheels.

The stunt granny works best on smooth flat surfaces.

Steering adjustment

On the bottom of the granny there is a small steering adjustment. If the Granny is not travelling in a straight line when you push forward on the controller, adjust this adjustment a little to the left or the right.

Setting up the props

You can use the props to set up stunts and courses. Do NOT drive the granny off from any heights higher than the ramp itself – this will cause damage to the product.

Switch off the granny and the controller after use.

Battery instructions:

Unscrew the battery compartment and slide off the cover to insert batteries. For the granny, use 3 x 1.5V "AAA" batteries (not included).

For the controller, use 3 x 1.5V "AAA" batteries (not included).

Switch product off before inserting batteries.

Please read instructions before use.

Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.

Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not be mixed.

Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used. Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.

Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the product.

The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
