HOW TO USE YOUR 2X TWO WHEELS MOUSE

Just One click “**2X Button**” straightly open files and programs easily, click once instead of twice, without any driver



With click the **6th button** to display a 2X-wheeljump menu, it provides you the marked 4 different functions sets for the 2nd wheel.

SETTING UP YOUR MOUSE PAD AND MOUSE

1. Plug the Mouse Pad's USB plug to your computer's USB port.
2. PWR LED on the Mouse Pad will be flashing in "RED"
3. Put the MOUSE onto the center of the MOUSE PAD.
4. PWR LED on the Mouse Pad will stop flashing become steady "RED"
5. Press the button "TUNE" to obtain the frequency for best performance. Do not move the mouse while the RUN LED is flashing in "GREEN"
6. You may move the mouse around once the RUN LED stopped flashing in "GREEN"
7. If the cursor doesn't move smoothly, please repeat steps 5 to 7.
8. RUN LED should light up with steady "GREEN" while mouse is circulating on the mouse pad.



NOTE:

1. Do not use this product on any metal table or surface. The metal surface may interfere with the cross induction and have an adverse effect on the mouse operation.
2. Keep working temperature under 0 to 50 degree Celsius (0°– 50°C).
3. Frequency: 121 KHz-128KHz
4. Keep your credit cards and ATM cards away from RFID Mouse Pad to prevent the card's magnetic stripe from losing its efficiency.
5. Our RFID Mouse Pad will not erase any data in the memory stick. So don't worry if your memory stick is close to the inductive RFID mouse pad.

Installing the software 2X-Wheel

By installing the 2X-Wheel, it enables various functions provided for the scrolling wheel(s) and buttons.

STEP ONE: HOW TO INSTALL 2X-WHEEL (For Windows Me / 2000 / 2003 / XP / X64)

1. **MUST:** Please uninstall any previous mouse driver before installing the 2X-Wheel
2. **MUST:** Make sure you have completely finished setting up your mouse pad and mouse
3. Insert the included Compact Disc (CD) into your CD-ROM
4. Click “Install Driver”
5. Select model: BatteryFREE 2X Two Wheel NB-90D
6. Click the button on the right to install driver
7. Follow the on screen instruction to complete your installation
8. Restart your computer after the driver has been installed

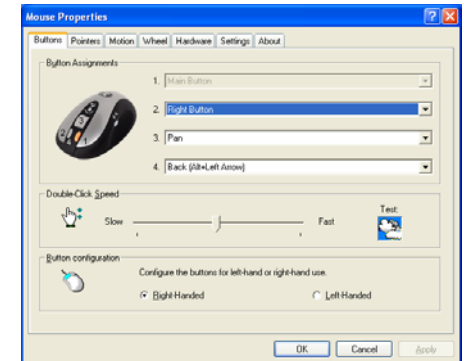
9. You will see a mouse icon “” appear on the bottom right of

your task bar (near the clock area)



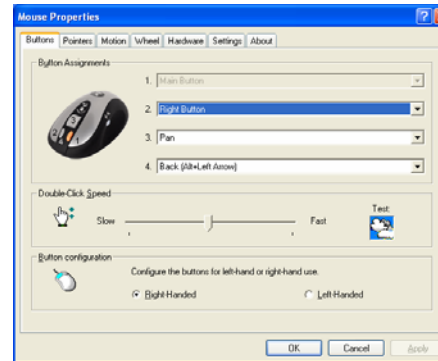
10. Double click on the mouse icon “” will bring you the mouse property (figure on the right)

11. If the mouse image appears in the mouse properties menu looks exactly the same as the mouse on hand, then this means that you have successfully installed the 2X-Wheel driver

STEP TWO: HOW TO PROGRAM YOUR MOUSE SETTINGS



1. Button is the first tab appears in your mouse properties
2. The mouse image that appears in the first section “Button Assignments” is a key to numbers listed to the right.
3. For example, # 1 button has been assigned as “Main Button” by default and it's not programmable.
4. # 2 button has been assigned as “Right Button” which works as right click for your mouse
5. # 3 button has been assigned as “Pan” function by default. It's a vertical scrolling wheel if you scroll it. Also known as “Wheel Button” because it's a #3 button if you click it.



6. #2nd # 3rd # 4th Buttons can be set as any of 58 available commands and settings if you click the scrolling bar listed on the “button” tab to obtain the dropping –down shortcuts command menu ,from where ,you can assign the shortcuts command for the button you want.
7. The 2nd Wheel on the right side of the mouse comes in 4 different functions and will be explained later.

STEP THREE: LEARN HOW TO SET THE 2ND WHEEL

There are 2 ways to set 2nd Wheel

1. Click the 6th “2X-WheelJump” button located on your physical Mouse Body. A ring shape icon with four square shape ones built-in will pop up for you to set four different functions for the 2nd wheel (figure on the right). Just click any of four function icons , you can assign the corresponding function for the 2nd wheel at a time , they are : horizontal scrolling function ,zoom in/out function, backward/forward the page , previous /next documents in turn.

2. Click  appearing on the bottom right of your task bar (near the clock area)

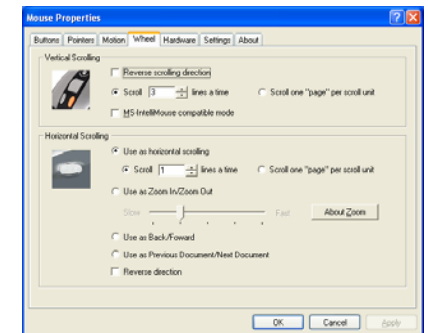


and it will bring you the mouse Properties window

(figure on the right) and choose and click “ wheel “ button to open “ Mouse

Wheel content “ dialogue ,here , you can set the wheel function features listed

in the wheel window as your need (figure on the right).



There are 4 selections in the 2X-Wheel menus for 2nd wheel. You may choose up to 1 selection at a time.

has been selected, then the wheel will work as horizontal scrolling.
