



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Charging the speaker

For best results, fully charge the speaker before use.

- Connect the USB cord (included) to the charging port of the speaker and insert the other end into a port on your computer or similar suitable power source.
- The Red LED turns on, indicating that the battery is being charged. Once it is fully charged, the Red LED will turn off. It takes about 4 hours to charge the speaker fully.

Turn On/Off the Speaker

- Turn "ON": Add the "ON/OFF" switch to the ON Position.
- Turn "OFF": Add the "ON/OFF" switch to the OFF Position.

Switch the speaker to Bluetooth pairing mode:

- Turn On the speaker.
- You would hear the indicator tone and LED Flashing Lights are on. The speaker is now in pairing mode. (Note: Speaker will automatically pair with previously paired device)

Pairing your device with Bluetooth Speaker:

Your Bluetooth Speaker can wirelessly stream audio from any Bluetooth enabled device within 27-33 Feet. Simply follow the below steps:

- Turn On the speaker.
- You would hear the indicator tone and LED Flashing Lights are on. The speaker is now in pairing mode.
- Turn on the Bluetooth on your Mobile Phone or Tablet or Computer.
- It will show for various devices.
- The pairing name of our Bluetooth Speaker is "THE ILLUMINATOR", pair with this device.
- If required, enter the password "0000" to confirm to finalize pairing.
- Once paired successfully, you would hear an indication tone.
- If you fail to pair it within the time frame or you want to pair it with a new device please follow the steps outlined above.

Select your favorite song or the Bluetooth device and music would now stream through Bluetooth speaker

Listening using Bluetooth Speaker:

Please ensure that your cell phone is paired with the Bluetooth Speaker to use the below functions.

Function	Operation	Button
Access Incoming Call	Incoming Call	Press the MP3 button once to answer an incoming call.
End Call	Incoming Call	After your phone connection, short press the MP3 button.
Volume Increase	During a call	Long press on the MP3 button will increase the volume.
Volume Decrease	During a call	Long press on the MP3 button will decrease the volume.
Redial last number	Standby mode and connected to device.	Short press the MP3 button twice.

Listening to Music Wirelessly

Please ensure that your device (Phone, Tablet or Other Smart Phone) is paired with the Bluetooth Speaker to stream music wirelessly. Once it is paired, play music from your device.

Function	Operation	Button
Increase Volume	Playing music	A long press on the MP3 button will increase the volume.
Decrease Volume	Playing music	A long press on the MP3 button will decrease the volume.
Play	Playing music	Short press MP3 once to pause the music.
Pause	Playing music	Short press MP3 once to resume the music.
Previous track	Playing music	Short press the MP3 button to the previous track.
Next track	Playing music	Short press the MP3 button to the next track.

Note: An indication tone will alert you when the volume is adjusted to minimum or maximum level.

Note: Function of the Speaker (to play music) from non-Bluetooth devices is limited to the auxiliary port of the speaker. And, connect the other end of the cable to the audio device (such as MP3 Players, computer / tablet, etc.).

Note: Safety you always wear the sound device.

Note: Once AUX cable is connected to the Speaker, music through the Bluetooth will be stopped. Function

Accept increase/decrease volume like Skip Backward, Skip Forward etc can be only controlled through source device, while playing music in auxiliary mode.

Listening to Music using USB/TF Card Slot

- Turn on the speaker.
- Insert TF card or USB flash drive into the TF Card Slot or USB Slot. Music would be automatically streamed.
- Short press **MP3** button to move forward or backward on your playlist.
- Short press **MP3** button to Play or Pause a track.

Note: While using Bluetooth, if you insert TF Card or USB flash drive, speaker would disconnect the Bluetooth connection and switch to TF card or USB card function. You can short press Mode button each time until you press back Bluetooth mode.

TF Card/USB flash drive not included.

FM Radio

- Turn On the Speaker.
- Insert the auxiliary cord (included) into the auxiliary port. Leave the other end of the cord open. Auxiliary cord serves as FM Antenna while in FM Radio mode.
- Short press Mode button each time until FM mode is selected.
- Short press **MP3** button and the device would automatically search and store all the FM Radio stations.
- Short press **MP3** button to change the FM Radio stations.

Tip!

- Short press the Mode button each time to switch different functions of the speaker. The modes appear in the following sequence: Bluetooth / USB/TF / FM Radio / AUX In.

2. When the unit is not in use, turn OFF the device to save the battery power.

Do's and Don'ts

Do not play music at excessive levels as damage to hearing or equipment may result.

Do not use wet or in damp surroundings.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low sound level	Quiet, Tired, Noisy, Phone, Laptop, etc.	Adjust source volume.
Battery not hold	Battery check	Charge Battery.
Sound muted	Battery nearly dead	Charge Battery.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound at all	Source is Tired, Mobile, Phone, Laptop, turned off.	Turn the source on.
	Speaker turned off.	Turn the speaker on.
	Volume turned down source.	Adjust volume source.
	Not a paired up source.	Re-pair from source.

Care and Maintenance

Clean the unit with soft, damp cloth. Never use chemicals or hard brushes.
