Storing a Frequency as a Preset

Once you have located a clear frequency, you can store it as a preset on your transmitter so that you can access it with the press of a button—no need to tune up and down every time. You can set one or two frequencies as presets.

- Turn your iPod on.
- Plug the Kensington* Pico FM Transmitter (A) into your iPod.
 The iPod should display Tuning mode; if it does not, press the Select (E) switch on the Pico FM Transmitter to enter Tuning mode.



- Tune the Pico FM Transmitter (A) using the + Up (C) or Down (D) switches until the desired frequency is displayed. Press and hold for faster tuning. For maximum performance, find a clear frequency with pure static—that is, a frequency with no music or talking, just static.
- When the desired frequency is displayed, press and hold the Select (E) switch. The preset icons alternately flash, prompting you to select which preset (1 or 2) to store.
- Press and hold the + Up (C) or Down (D) switch to store the frequency as preset 1 or 2. The selected preset icon remains solid to confirm your selection.
- The iPod displays the main menu screen and starts playing the last song in memory. After about 10 seconds, the iPod display changes from the main menu screen to your song screen.

Accessing a Preset Frequency

After you store a frequency as a preset, all you need to do to listen to music from your iPod on your stereo is to tune the stereo to the preset frequency and then press a button on your transmitter.

- 1. Turn your iPod on.
- Plug the Kensington Pico FM Transmitter (A) into your iPod.
 If the iPod displays Tuning mode, press the Select (E) switch
 on the transmitter (A) to enter Normal mode. If the iPod
 already displays Normal mode, go to step 3.



- Press and hold the + Up (C) or Down (D) switch to access preset 1 or 2.
- The Pico FM Transmitter (A) changes frequency to the preset you selected.

Note: The transmitter does not provide any indication that you have tuned to the preset frequency.

- Make sure your iPod is fully charged. The Kensington Pico FM Transmitter draws power from your iPod.
- Make sure the volume level on your stereo is turned up.
- Make sure that the frequency on your Kensington Pico FM.
 Transmitter is the same as the frequency on your stereo.
