



WIRELESS SPEAKER DESCRIPTIONS


- Press and hold the Opower button for one seconds to turn on the speaker, repeat these steps to place the speaker in standby mode. A confirmation "Green" LED will flash once the speaker has been turned on.
- EZ Play: Press and hold the EZ Play button to shift between master (transmitting) or slave (receiving). Both speakers will have a confirmation LED flash and display solid to confirm an EZ Play connection has been made.
- 3 Bluetooth \$:

When the speaker is turned on it will automatically try to pair via Bluetooth to it's last known device.


To enter pairing mode and establish a new connection press and hold the Bluetooth button for two seconds or until you hear a confirmation voice stating "Pairing".



GETTING STARTED



- Connect the supplied AC cable to Speaker
- Plug the AC cord into wall outlets.




Green Amber Blue

Power On/Off button

- Power on the button Power Switch.
- The Power Green LED will turn On. you will hear Voice confirmation *Power on*.
- By default, the unit will enter into BT mode, the BT Blue LED will flash.
- If the 3.5mm Stereo Audio cable is plugged in during this Power On mode, it will automatically enter into Aux mode.
- If the unit is left no action for more than 2 minutes, the unit will enter to Standby mode automatically. All LEDs turn Off.

Charging Battery



- By connecting AC power, batteries will be charged and Red LED will turn on.
- Red LED indicator will turn off when unit is fully charged.
- If Red LED indicator is flashing, this means that battery levels are low and need charging.
- Charge batteries about 10 hours before you start using the units for the first time.


Bluetooth pairing by using NFC

- Turn on NFC function on your Bluetooth enabled device.
- Place your Bluetooth device on the silkscreen "NFC" on the top surface of the Monster Tower.
- Confirm Bluetooth connection on your Bluetooth device.
- Note: Blue LED indicator Power will be solid.
- Once paired you can play audio from your Bluetooth device and audio can be heard from the unit.

Note: If pairing won't complete automatically, your Bluetooth device might not be NFC enabled.


Manual Bluetooth pairing

- · Place the Monster Tower and your Bluetooth device so that they are no more than 3 feet apart.
- Press and hold the Bluetooth button on the Monster Tower for 2 Seconds to enter into Bluetooth pairing mode.
 Bluetooth LED will flash rapidly.




Manual Bluetooth pairing-continued

- Set your Bluetooth device to search for Bluetooth devices.
 You will recognize the unit by its Bluetooth name "Monster Tower".
- · Bluetooth LED will turn solid Blue upon completion of pairing.



EZ PLAY WIRELESS CONNECTION

- Press and hold the "EZ Play" button on the speaker for 2 seconds to send a connection request to a second unit.
 NOTE: This function can only be completed with other EZ Play speakers.
- EZ Play Amber LED will pulse on the transmitting speaker.
- Press and hold the "EZ Play" button on the transmitting speaker for 2 seconds to scan for a connection request from the receiving speaker.
- EZ Play Amber LED on the transmitting speaker will flash during scanning feature.
- EZ Play Amber LED on both units will turn solid upon completion of connection.
- Once complete both speakers will play the same audio coming from the transmitting speaker.



EZPlay Auto Connect

Once a wireless connection is established the transmitting speaker and the receiving speaker will connect automatically whenever powered on.

- You can wireless connect additional speakers (up to 8) additional Monster Tower of Music speakers sold separately.



Transmitting speaker to receiver conversion

- Turn the speaker on.
- Press the TEPlay button the "transmit" LED will switch to "receive" LED.
- Bluetooth function will be disabled and Bluetooth LED will turn off.


To connect additional units repeat the steps above on each speaker.


NOTE: When a speaker is converted to a receiving unit the LINE IN and Bluetooth feature will be disabled.



CONNECTING A MOBILE DEVICE USING THE LINE IN (AUX) INPUT

- Press and hold the "EZ Play" button on the speaker for 2 seconds to send a connection request to a second unit.
 NOTE: This function can only be completed with other EZ Play speakers.
- You can connect any audio source that has a 3.5mm audio output jack with the Monster Tower Speaker
 NOTE: All playback functions (Play,Pause,Next,Previous,Volume UP & Volume Down) can easily be controlled from the connected source (MP3, Mobile Phone, etc..)
