



How to Play MP3 File

FM Channel Dip Switch

- 1. First of all, you have to plug a removable USB Memory into USB Connector at MP3 Player.
- 2. Set the FM channel of MP3 Player, and then set the FM Channel of FM Receiver (radio) as same as MP3 Player.
 - Caution: When you set the FM channel of CAR MP3 Player, you had better set the clear channel referring to "How to Tune in FM Frequency of CAR MP3 Player".
- 3. Finally, push the play button.
