Nighttime Lighting System

With the new easy-to-install PathLights lighting system, your path will automatically light up under low-light conditions. Using our Instant Lit technology, “A” light units alert “B” light units to turn on immediately lighting your way with a warm glow that brightens your path. The lights remain on for approximately one minute, giving you the time you need to walk up or down stairs or a dark hallway, and then turn off automatically. Nothing could be simpler.

PathLights can be mounted onto any wall surface using the included double-stick tape or screws. It takes less than 5 minutes to install the three lights in this package. For interior use only.

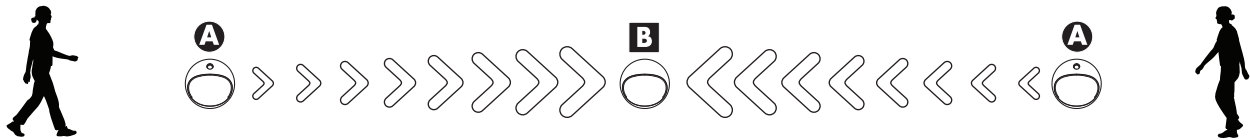
- PathLights work under low-light conditions only.
- The 3 PathLights function as a system - not designed to work as individual units.
- PathLights stay on for about one-minute and then turn off automatically.

How do PathLights work?

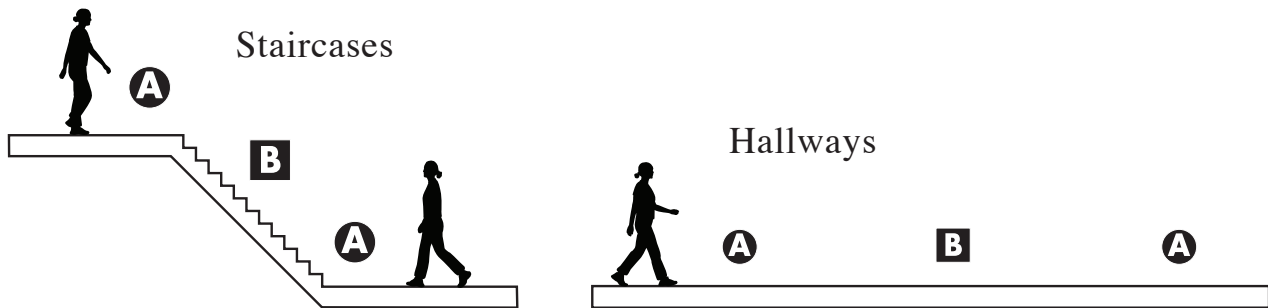
PathLights are designed to work only under low-light conditions - they do not turn on unless it's dark.

The **A** UNITS sense the light level in the room. Motion detection is only activated when it's dark.

Motion detecting **A** UNITS activate **B** UNITS within 18 feet of the **A** UNITS and automatically lights your way.



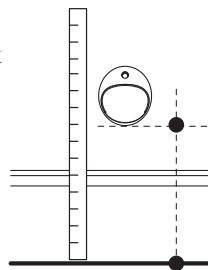
Where can I put my PathLights?



Mounting PathLights to the Wall

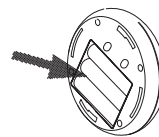
- 1 Find the 3 plastic mounting plates (back of units) in the package.

Determine where you want to place your PathLights. Refer to “**Where can I put my PathLights?**” above as a guide.

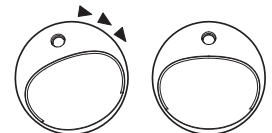
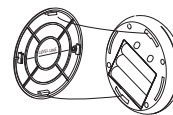


8”-10” from floor/step to bottom of PathLight

- 2 Attach the mounting plates to the wall - about 8 inches to 10 inches from the floor - using either the enclosed screws or the attached double-stick tape. Make sure that the mounting plate is oriented correctly -- the words “LEVEL LINE” on the mounting plate should be horizontal and readable.



- 3 Insert 3 “AA” batteries into each unit as indicated in battery compartment.



- 4 Rotate each unit clockwise onto a mounting plate until it comes to a stop.
