


Flat panel manual

To users: Thank you for purchasing rixiao photoelectric products. Please read the manual carefully before installation and use

Installation instructions: Before installation, be sure to cut off the power supply to protect the safety of operators.



Installation steps

1. Remove the corresponding gusset plate from the ceiling where the lamp is installed;
2. Connect the power cord between the lamp body and the driver;
3. Connect the power cord according to the polarity direction of the driver;
4. Buckle the lamp body into the keel groove where the buckle plate is removed
5. Lamps can also be installed on other solid objects

Safety precautions

1. The power supply should not exceed the specified range (input voltage range: 100-240V, frequency: 50 Hz);
2. Do not install the lamp on the open air, inclined place or unsound objects
3. Do not use with dimmer and electronic switch
4. In order to ensure the safety, maintenance and inspection of lamps and lanterns, please entrust electrical professionals
5. When the lamp is abnormal, please cut off the power supply quickly and contact the sales shop
