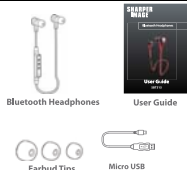

**Charging the Bluetooth Headphones**

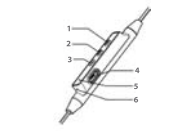
1. Connect the small end of the Micro USB cable to one charging port on the headphones.
2. Connect the large end of the Micro USB cable to your computer's USB port or an AC adapter (not included).
3. The LED indicator light turns RED when charging.
4. When fully charged, the LED indicator light turns BLUE.



**NOTE:** When the power is low, a voice prompt "Battery low" will be heard every 20 seconds, while the LED indicator light turns RED and begins to flash.

**NOTE:** Make sure you charge your headphones for at least 2 hours before using them for the first time.

**Location of Controls**



1. [+ ] button - quickpress = volume up  
press and HOLD = next track
2. [+ ] button - Power: stop/pause music, answer call
3. [- ] button - quickpress = volume down  
press and HOLD = previous track
4. Micro USB charging port
5. Microphone
6. LED indicator light

**Pairing the headphones with a Bluetooth enabled device**

1. Press and HOLD the [+ ] button for 5 seconds to turn ON the Bluetooth headphones and enter pairing mode.
2. A tone and the voice "Pairing" will be heard. The LED indicator light will alternately flash RED and BLUE.
3. Keep your Bluetooth headphones and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
4. Set your mobile phone or other Bluetooth enabled device to search for Bluetooth devices.

**NOTE:** If a paired device is in range when the sound bar is in Bluetooth mode, the headphones will connect to it automatically.



**NOTE:** Some Bluetooth enabled devices may not be compatible with the headphones, and are not used to assist in the operation of the pairing process. Your Bluetooth enabled device's manufacturer's instructions with the headphones may slightly differ from the Bluetooth phone.

**Using your Bluetooth Headphones**

- **Power ON/OFF**  
To turn ON, press and HOLD the [+ ] button for 3 seconds. A tone and the voice "Power on" will be heard.  
To turn OFF, press and HOLD the [+ ] button for 3 seconds. A tone and the voice "Power off" will be heard.
- **Adjusting the volume**  
Quickpress the [+ ] button to increase the volume.  
Quickpress the [- ] button to decrease the volume.

**NOTE:** You can also adjust the volume from your mobile phone's volume control.



**NOTE:** When the power is low, a voice prompt "Battery low" will be heard every 20 seconds, while the LED indicator light turns RED and begins to flash.

**On an Android Phone**

Go to **SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH > MENU > Search for devices** (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)



**On other Cell Phones/Devices**

Follow the instruction manual that came with your phone/device.



5. When the Bluetooth enabled device finds the headphones, select "SBT517" from the list of found devices.
6. If required, enter the password 0000. Select OK or Yes to pair with your device.
7. After a successful registration, a tone will sound and the voice "Pairing successful" will be heard. The LED indicator light will slowly flash BLUE.

**NOTE:** The SBT517 supports Multi-connection that allows for the simultaneous use of the headphones with two mobile phones. After pairing successfully with two mobile phones, turn off the headphones and then turn them on again — the headphones will connect to both phones automatically.

**NOTE:** Some Bluetooth enabled devices may not be compatible with the headphones, and are not used to assist in the operation of the pairing process. Your Bluetooth enabled device's manufacturer's instructions with the headphones may slightly differ from the Bluetooth phone.

**Powering ON/OFF**

- To turn ON, press and HOLD the [+ ] button for 3 seconds. A tone and the voice "Power on" will be heard.
- To turn OFF, press and HOLD the [+ ] button for 3 seconds. A tone and the voice "Power off" will be heard.

**Adjusting the volume**

- Quickpress the [+ ] button to increase the volume.
- Quickpress the [- ] button to decrease the volume.

**NOTE:** You can also adjust the volume from your mobile phone's volume control.

**Answering/ending a call**

- To answer a call, quickpress the [+ ] button.
- To end a call, quickpress the [+ ] button again.

**Rejecting an incoming call**

To reject an incoming call, press and HOLD the [+ ] button for 2 seconds.

**Redialing the last number called**

In standby, double press the [+ ] button. The last number called will be redialed.

**NOTE:** Redialing the last number is possible only for the first phone if two mobile phones are connected. The connection sequence on the secondary connecting manually.

**Transferring a call to your phone**

Press and HOLD the [+ ] button for 2 seconds to transfer the call between the phone and headset.

**Call waiting**

-If there is an incoming call while a call is in progress, quickpress the [+ ] button to accept the waiting call and end the current call.

-If there is an incoming call while a call is in progress, press and HOLD the [+ ] button for 2 seconds to accept the incoming call and place the current call on hold.

**Mute**

While a call is in progress, press and HOLD the [- ] button for 2 seconds. While in mute mode, you will hear a beep every 10 seconds. To cancel mute mode, press and HOLD the [- ] button again.

**NOTE:** The mute will pause automatically with a call if a valid outgoing call, and resume when the connection has ended.

**Battery status**

Quickpress the [+ ] button 2 times, and a voice will state the battery power level status.

**Wearing the headphones**

Follow the illustrations below to properly wear the headphones.



**Playing Music**

To enjoy wireless music on your Bluetooth Headphones, make sure you are connected to a Bluetooth enabled device. Once connected, you can control the music with the controls on your connected device (which must have the AVRCP Bluetooth profile).

**NOTE:** Most mobile enabled smart phones will properly connect to the phone and the headset when connected to the Bluetooth headphones. This means you can make phone calls and enjoy your music.

**Adjusting the volume**

- Quickpress the [+ ] button to increase the volume.
- Quickpress the [- ] button to decrease the volume.

**NOTE:** You can also adjust the volume from your mobile phone's volume control.

**Play/pause**

- Quickpress the [+ ] button to play/pause music.
- Press and HOLD the [+ ] button to stop play.

**Skipping songs**

- Press and HOLD the [+ ] button to skip to the next track.
- Press and HOLD the [- ] button to skip to the previous track.

**Troubleshooting Tips**

**1. I can't pair the Bluetooth headphones with my Bluetooth device, but I cannot hear any music.**

1. Make sure your Bluetooth device supports A2DP profile.
2. Turn up the volume on your Bluetooth device.
3. You may have to unpair the headphones, then re-pair to your device.

**2. I cannot get the Bluetooth headphones into pairing mode.**

1. Make sure the Bluetooth headphones are turned ON before beginning the pairing process.
2. A tone will sound, indicating that the headphones are in pairing mode. The LED indicator light will alternately blink RED and BLUE.

**3. Check that the headphones are charged.**

**4. My Bluetooth Device is not able to pair with the Bluetooth headphones.**

1. Make sure the Bluetooth headphones are turned ON before beginning the pairing process.
2. Keep your headphones and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
3. Check that YOUR device's Bluetooth feature is turned ON.
4. Try repeating the pairing process, see "Pairing the headphones with a Bluetooth enabled device".
