

First Time Use

Charging the Battery


The SP2-17715 Speaker has a built-in, rechargeable lithium-polymer battery. To avoid damage, do not attempt to remove the battery and the full performance of the battery is achieved after two or three charging-discharging cycles. Charge the battery fully before first use.

- 1. Connect the USB cable to the speaker's charging port.
- Plug in to a suitable power outlet (wall, computer).
- When the charger is pluggrd in, a red indicator light will turn on as the battery charges.

 $\textbf{Note} \colon \textbf{Charging the battery fully may take up to 2 hours.}$

4. When the battery is fully charged, the red indicator light will turn off. Disconnect the charger from the speaker and the outlet. The speaker is ready for use.

Note: Overcharging could reduce the life of the battery. A charged battery will lose its capacity if it is not used on a regular basis.



Important!

Ensure that the battery is fully charged if the speaker is not used for a long period of time. To avoid a complete discharge of the battery, charge the speaker at least every


Battery Notes

- When the battery power is low, the speaker will beep every 30 seconds.
- When pairing your speaker with an iPhone, an additional battery meter will appear on your phone's touch screen.

Pairing with your Phone

- 1. Place the speaker in close range of a Bluetooth® enabled mobile phone.
- 2. Press and hold POWER button for 3 seconds to power on your speaker. The Bluetooth indicator light will alternately flash blue and red to indicate that your speaker is in pairing mode.
- 3. Go to the Bluetooth Manager of your phone. Make sure that Bluetooth functionality is turned on and search for Bluetooth devices.
- 4. Select "Rubix speaker" from the list shown on your phone.
- 5. If requested, enter the PIN code "0000" and confirm the entry. The Bluetooth indicator light will blink blue every 4 seconds when your speaker is paired with your phone.

Note: If pairing is not completed within 10 minutes, the speaker will turn off. If this happens, repeat the pairing steps above.



General Operation


Turning ON/OFF

- 1. Press and hold the POWER button for 3 seconds to turn the speaker ON. If you have already paired your speaker to your Bluetooth device, they will automatically remain paired each time you power on your speaker.
- 2. Press and hold the POWER button for 4 seconds to turn the speaker OFF.
- Note: The speaker will turn OFF automatically when not connected to a mobile device for approximately 10

Music Playback

• Play/Pause button: Press to play or pause a track.

• Quickly press the LED button 2 times to turn the LED Lights on or off.
