#### Charging Your Speaker

This speaker has a built-in rechargeable Lithium-ion battery. Fully charge the speaker before first use. Charge the battery as follows:

- 1 Connect the speaker to your PC with the supplied micro USB cable or a 5V/1A power adapter (not included).
- 2. When charging a red LED light will illuminate to indicate charging.
- 3. When the battery is fully charged, the red LED light will turn off.
- 4. When the battery is low, the speaker turns off automatically after 4 beeps; charge the speaker.

Note: The internal battery of your speaker takes approximately 2.5 - 3.5 hours to charge when completely drained. The operating time of the speaker is approximately 3-8 hours according to different light modes and volume level.

## Turning your speaker ON and OFF

Press the **O** button once to turn the speaker "ON". After 3 seconds, the lights on the speaker will appear and the blue indicator light blinks. To turn the speaker "OFF" press the o button. The lights on the speaker will disappear and the

Note: When the speaker is powered "ON" and not in use for 15 minutes, the speaker will turn "OFF" automatically to save battery life.

blue LED indicator turns off.

#### Pairing a Bluetooth Device to Your Speaker

- 1. Make sure your Bluetooth audio source is held within 10 meters of your speaker.
- 2. Press the **O** button. After 3 seconds, the lights on the speaker will appear and the blue LED indicator blinks. The speaker is now ready for pairing.
- 3. Go to the Bluetooth Manager of your Bluetooth audio source.
- 4. Search Bluetooth devices and select your speaker to start connecting. Look for name "HR Flash".
- 5. Pair your Bluetooth audio source with the speaker. If asked for a password enter "0000". You will hear a beep, the speaker has successfully paired with your Bluetooth audio source.

Tip: Once the speaker is paired and connected to your Bluetooth audio source, next time when you switch on the speaker it will connect automatically is long your Bluetooth function is switched ON your audio device.

# NFC function

- 1. Enable the NFC function on your device.
- 2. Use your NFC enabled device and touch the NFC logo on the speaker, the lights on the speaker will
- 3. There may be a connection request message on your audio device, press "Yes" to accept the connection with the speaker
- 4. When you hear a beep the speaker has successfully paired with your audio source.

# Hands-free speakerphone

When a smartphone is connected to your speaker follow the steps below to take calls hands-free.

- 1. Press nbutton to pick up the call.
- 2. Press the 
  button again to hang up the call.

Note: The phone button on the speaker only operates in Bluetooth mode. If you receive a call while listening to music on the speaker the music will pause. When the call is ended the music will resume.

#### Connect to other audio source

Use the supplied 3.5mm Audio cable to connect the speaker directly with your audio device. The Bluetooth connection will disconnect while using the auxillary line-in.
