




GETTING STARTED

Power Connection




- Connect the supplied AC cable to Tx and Rx units.
- Plug the AC cord into wall outlets.



Power On/Off Switch

- Power on the mechanical Power Switch.
- The Power Green LED will turn On. you will hear Voice confirmation "Power on".
- For Tx unit, by default, the unit will enter into BT mode, the BT Blue LED will flash.
- If the 3.5mm Stereo Audio cable is plugged in during this Power On mode, it will automatically enter into Aux mode.
- If the unit is left no action for more than 10 minutes, the unit will enter to Standby mode automatically. All LEDs turn Off.
- Press "BT" or "5.8G" button to wake up the unit.
- Note: The unit will not go into Standby in Aux mode.


Charging Battery




- By connecting AC power, batteries will be charged and Red LED will turn on.
- Red LED indicator will turn off when unit is fully charged.
- If Red LED indicator is flashing, this means that battery levels are low and need charging.
- Charge batteries about 10 hours before you start using the units for the first time.

BLUETOOTH CONNECTION (Bluetooth Devices And Tx Unit)

- Make sure to unplug the Aux input audio cable if any.
- Press the "BT" button for 3 seconds for the unit enter into BT pairing mode. you will hear "Pairing" BT Blue LED will Fast Flashing.
- Turn on your Bluetooth device and scan for surrounding Bluetooth's accessory.
- Find the Bluetooth accessory name " BTW248XBK " and pair with it, you will hear Pairing completed.
- After the Bluetooth device is paired, the BT Blue LED on the Tx unit will turn steady On.
- If Bluetooth device is not paired, you will hear "pairing not completed"
- Anyother bluetooth device to pair this vnit, when other bluetooth try to connect this vnit, you will hear "Disconnelted"
- Once paired, you can play audio from your Bluetooth device and the audio can be heard from this speaker unit.
- All the playback functions (Play, Pause, Next, Previous, Volume Up & Volume Down) can be controlled from your connected Bluetooth device.






5.8G WIRELESS CONNECTION (Tx Unit And Rx UNIT)

- Press and hold the "5.8G" button on the Rx unit for 3 seconds to send connection request to Tx unit.
- 5.8G Amber LED on Rx unit will flash.
- Press and hold the "5.8G" button on the Tx unit for 3 seconds to scan connection request from Rx unit.
- 5.8G Amber LED on Tx unit will flash during scanning.
- 5.8G Amber LED on both units will turn steady on upon completion of connection.
- Once complete, the same audio sound from the Tx unit is reproduced in the Rx unit.

Wireless Speaker Auto Connection

Once the above wireless connection is completed, the Tx unit an the Rx unit will be connected automatically whenever they are turned on together.



CONNECT TO MULTIPLE SETS OF BTW248 XBKSPEAKERS

- You can wirelessly connect multiple speakers (up to 8 units) by purchasing extra sets of BTW248XKB
- Tx units of the extra BTW248XKB sets need to be converted to Receiver unit so that they can be wirelessly connected to the Tx unit of 1st BTW248XKB set.

 Converting Tx Unit

Tx to Rx conversion

- Slide BT On/Off Switch located at the bottom of Tx unit to Off position.
- Turn the Power switch to Off, and then On again to reset the unit.
- In this case, BT function is turn off, and BT Blue LED will turn off.
- Tx unit is now converted to the Receiver unit and will function like the Rx unit.
- Aux In will not function after above conversion.

To connect 3rd~7th additional speaker units


- Repeat the same steps described in "5,8G Wireless Connection (Tx Unit And Rx Unit)" above.

NFC technology audio transmission

- Enable NFC on your Blutetooth device.
- Touch Blutetooth device to the NFC activity field at the upper part of the speaker.
- It will be automatically made a request for device Blutetooth device.
- Click"OK"on you Blutetooth device screen,and the device is connected successfully
- To disable the connection,re-touch Blutetooth device to the NFC activity field.

Resume back from Rx to Tx

- Slide BT On/Off Switch to On position.
- Turn the Power Switch to Off, and then On again to reset the unit.
- Unit is now resumed back to Tx unit and will function as Tx unit.

CONNECTION USING AUX INPUT

- Plug in the 3.5mm Stereo Audio wire into the Aux-In input, and the unit will
 enter into Aux mode and the BT Blue LED Indicator will turn off.
- You can connect any audio device that has 3.5mm audio output jack, and can playback any audio from this connected deivce.
- All playback functions (Play, Pause, Next, Previous, Volume Up & Volume Down) can be controlled from the connected Audio device,






WALL MOUNTING

Use the supplied template with the following instructions.

- 1. Mark for 2 holes A and B on the wall where you want to mount the speaker by using the supplied template.
- 2. Make 2 holes on the points where you marked on the wall by using a #8 (0.199", 5 mm) drill bit.
- 3. Insert the supplied anchors (Fig. 1) completely into the holes.
- 4. Make the screw sets that are shown in Fig. 2 by inserting the supplied metal screws into the supplied plastic sleeves, and install them to the anchors. Make sure that the plastic sleeves are firmly secured.
- 5. Hang the speaker on the screw sets by inserting the heads of the screws into the teardrop openings provided on the rear of the speaker. After inserting them, make sure to slide the speaker down by about 0.4" (11 mm) so that the top edges of both teardrop openings securely sit on the plastic sleeves.







TROUBLESHOOTING

General

No power

- Check the AC power cord is securely inserted in the unit and the electrical outlet.
- Check the Power On/Off switch is turn to On position.
- If battery is flat. Plug in the AC power cord to charge and operate.

Keys no response

- Turn the Power On/Off switch to Off, and then On again to reset the unit.
- Unplug the AC power cord and plug is back again.

No sound heard

- Make sure the Aux connected device volume is turn to reasonable level.
- Make sure the Bluetooth connected device output the audio thru BT out.
- Make sure the Bluetooth connected device volume is turn to reasonable level.

Bluetooth Operations

Audio quality is poor

- Bluetooth reception is poor. Move the Bluetooth device nearer to the Tx unit.

Cannot pair to Bluetooth device

- Make sure both Bluetooth device and Tx unit is not connected to any other Bluetooth device.
- Make sure the Bluetooth On/Off switch located below Tx unit is slide to On position.
- Make sure the Blue LED on the Tx unit is fast flashing (Pairing mode).
- Turn Power switch to Off, and then On again. Press and hold BT button for 3 seconds to enter into pairing mode.

5.8G Wireless Link Operations

Audio quality is poor

- 5.8G wireless reception is poor. Move the Receiver unit (Rx) nearer to the Tx unit.

Cannot connect the Receiver unit (Rx) to Tx

- Move the Rx unit near to the Tx during connection request.
- Turn Power switch to Off, and then On again. Press and hold 5.8G button for 3 seconds for sending wireless connection request.
