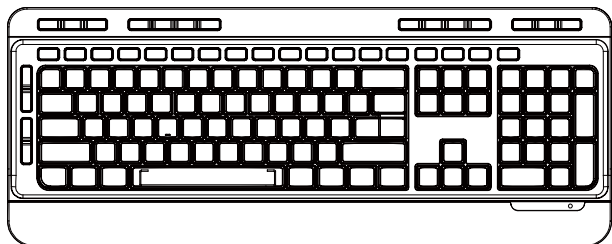

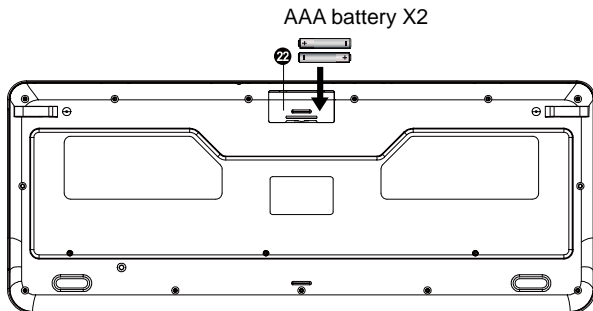
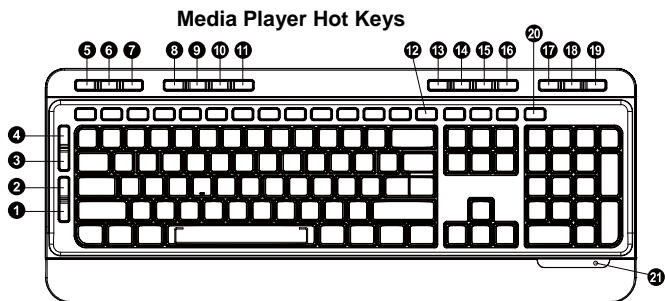
- Reorient or relocate the receiving antenna.

- Consult the dealer or an experienced radio/TV technician for help.













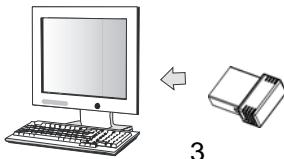
Keyboard Buttons

1.		Outlook(E-mail)→Default	Start the default e-mail program
2		Homepage(www/e)	Start the default Web browser and loads the home Web page
3.		Forward	Forward to the next page on Internet browser
4.		Back	Back to the last page on Internet browser
5.		Search	Open the Internet Explorer Search panel
6.		Refresh	Reload the current page
7.		My Favorites	Start my favorites
8.		Play/Pause	Switch between playing and pausing media
9.		Previous	Switch to the previous media track
10.		Next	Switch to the next media track
11.		Stop(Media)	Stop playing the media in the media player

Setup the Connection between the Receiver and the Keyboard.

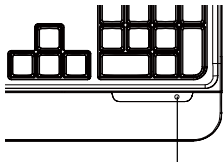
1. Insert the batteries into the Keyboard, then follow the steps below.
2. Plug the Nano receiver into the USB port of your computer.



3. If the keyboard is not working, please put it into pairing mode.
4. Pairing: Re-plug the receiver into the USB port of your computer, then press the “**ESC**” and “**K**” button on the keyboard. If the keyboard does not work after 10 seconds, pair them again. (The receiver has auto pairing function).



5. The LED indicator on keyboard flashes steadily when it is in pairing mode and stops blinking when it is successfully paired with the receiver.
6. When the batteries' power of the keyboard is low, the Low Power indicator will start to blink.
