L ANTENNA CONNECTION Connect the donor/server antenna cables to the M1C's antenna ports on top as shown in figure 1. Adjust antenna positioning to assure maximum RSSI and coverage.	 2 SOFTWARE INSTALL Place the installation CD into your CD-ROM. The setup will start automatically. Follow the InstallShield Wizard to completely install the M1C software. When prompted, connect the USB cable and install the driver. (Step 3) 	3 USB DRIVER INSTALLATION Connect the USB cable to your computer and the M1C. When the Found New Hardware wizard comes up, click next to automatically search the CD-ROM for drivers. *The installation CD must be in the CD-ROM.
4 SOFTWARE/POWER Now run the M1C software, and plug in the power converter. (AC/DC Adapter) Then turn on the M1C.	5 SOFTWARE COMMUNICATION After opening the software verify that it is communicating with the M1C by checking that the status window has loaded properly as shown in figure 5.	6 BAND SELECTION Go to INSTALL menu on the top of the GUI. Click on the band you want selected.
