1. Safety Approvals and Certification

Users are advised not to attempt to change or modify this device in any way. This device is not user-serviceable and changes or modifications will void the warranty.

1.1. FCC Notices

This equipment has been tested and found to comply with the limits for a Class B digital device, pursuant to Part 15 of the FCC Rules.
