

3. Setup

3.3. Switching the Headset on and off

Switching on:

- 1) Press the talk button for about seven seconds until you hear a high tone followed by a low tone. The LED indicator will flash green five times.
- 2) The Headset will now switch on and go to standby mode. The LED indicator will flash every three seconds continuously.

Switching off:

- 1) Press the talk button for about three seconds until you hear a low tone followed by a high tone. The LED indicator will flash red five times.

Note: When you see the red light, please release the button. If you continue to press, then the device will enter pairing mode and will not switch off.

- 2) The Headset will now switch off and the LED indicator will stop illuminating.

3.4. Pairing the Headset (Important)

Before you can use the Headset, it must first be paired with a Bluetooth technology enabled device such as a Bluetooth mobile phone.

Pairing is necessary for two devices to successfully communicate wirelessly. After creating the paired link, you will not need to repeat the procedure as the two devices will automatically communicate as long as both are switched on.

If you want to use this Headset with a different Bluetooth device, then the pairing procedure will have to be repeated.

The Headset may be paired with up to eight mobile phones.

3.5. Initiating the Pairing Procedure:

- 1) Place the Headset and the device that it will be paired with close together.



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- 2) Make sure your Headset is switched on and in standby mode. (The green LED blinks every three seconds)
- 3) Continually press the Talk button (about **seven seconds**) until the LED indicator begins to switch between green and red. The Headset is now ready for pairing with the mobile device.
- 4) Perform the Bluetooth Device Discovery routine from the menu on your mobile phone (For full details please consult your mobile phone user's manual.)
- 5) Once the Mobile Phone discovers the Headset, the word 'Headset[xxxx]' will appear on the LCD screen.
- 6) Follow the mobile phone instructions to enable pairing and when prompted to enter the passkey (Pin Code), enter the number: **0000** (Four zeros)
- 7) If the time runs over 60 seconds and the pairing was not completed, please repeat the above steps. The pairing status can be viewed from the mobile phone LCD screen.
- 8) When the pairing is successful, the phone LCD screen will notify you, and the LED on the Headset will flash continuously green ten times. The Headset is now in Standby mode.
- 9) Calls can now be made and received through the Headset.

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Before you try to use this Headset, please ensure that (1) the Headset is switched on and is paired with a Bluetooth mobile phone, and (2) the phone's Bluetooth feature is enabled, and the phone is close to the Headset. (See your mobile phone user's guide) Note that the range of bluetooth devices is typically 10 meters only.

Note: This Headset supports both Headset and Hands-Free profiles. Some types of mobile phone do not support all of the functions listed below Please look in your mobile phone user's guide to find the list of supported functions.

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4.1. Accepting a Call

When an incoming call is detected, the Headset will ring and the LED indicator will flash green at 3-second intervals. To receive the call from the Headset, press the Talk button once. The call can also be answered on your mobile phone in the normal way.

Note: If the mobile phone rings first, please wait until you hear a ring tone in the Headset, then press the Talk button to answer the call.

4.2. Ending a Call

To end a call, please press the Talk button once on the Headset, or you can press the Mobile Phone 'END' key.

4.3. Rejecting a call (Using hands-free profile supported phones)

When a call is received that you do not want to answer, please press the Talk button for 3 seconds. This will reject the call and return the Headset to standby mode.

Note: Please do not press the button for more than five seconds.

4.4. Making a Call

There are two ways to make a call:

A. Voice Activation

Note: To use Voice activation, the mobile phone has to support voice activated dialing. To find details on Voice dialing please refer to your mobile phone user's guide.

- 1) Press the Talk button once on your Headset.
- 2) After you hear a short tone, speak the name or voice recognition sound of the person you wish to connect to. (make sure that he/she has a voice tag on your phone)



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- 3) If the phone has found a match, in general, it will repeat the voice pattern, then the phone will automatically dial the number. You can see the details on the Phone LCD screen.

B. Dialing a number from your mobile phone

- 1) Dial the number from the mobile phone keypad.
- 2) Press the mobile phone send key to send the call.

4.5. Re-dialing the Last Number (With hands-free profile supported phone)

To redial, please press the volume down button on the headset for three seconds until you hear a tone, then release the button.

4.6. Volume Control

During a call the speaker volume can be adjusted using the volume up and volume down buttons. Press either repeatedly to adjust the volume. When the speaker volume reaches its maximum or minimum volume with no more available adjustment, you will hear two continuous tones.

4.7. Transferring a call between the Mobile Phone and your Headset.

You can transfer a call controlled by the cell phone or by the Headset.

- (1) Transferring a call controlled by the cell phone.

Please note that every Cell phone manufacturer has slightly different methods of transferring a call. Also some models of Cell phone do not support transfer functions.

- (2) Transferring a call controlled by the Headset.

A. When the cell phone and the Headset are connected, and the call is answered by using the cell phone, press the Vol Up button on the Headset for three seconds and you will hear a multi-tone. The call is then transferred. To transfer back again, press the Vol Up button for three seconds. The call is then transferred back to the cell phone.

B. When the Cell phone and the Headset are disconnected, answer the
