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
# **CAUTIONS FOR SAFETY**







# $\blacktriangleright$ Connecting the MP3 player to your PC




Please connect the USB cable to both the USB port, built in at the bottom of the MP3 player, and the USB port of your PC. The USB port is built in the bottom of the MP3 player.

Please connect the USB plug after uncovering the rubber cap of the USB port of the player.

\* Only a dedicated USB cable provided by Alltech Electronics should be used.

# ► CHARGING THE MP3 PLAYER BATTERY

This built-in battery MP3 player is automatically charged while it is connected to a PC.

# ▶ POWER ON





[POWER/PLAY] The power is turned 'ON' when the switch key is pressed somewhat long. (For around 3 seconds)

# ▶ POWER OFF





[POWER/PLAY] The power is turned 'OFF' when the switch key is re-pressed somewhat long. (For around 3 seconds)

## HOW TO LOAD MUSIC FILES ON THE MP3 PLAYER

1. After connecting the MP3 player to a PC, double-click on "My Computer/Removable Disk."



2. After copying the desired sound file, complete a copy after pasting the copied file into the removable disk.




Do not disconnect the MP3 player from the PC while a file is under transmission. The MP3 player may be malfunctioned.

- 3. When you double-click on the 'USB' icon shown at the bottom of the background screen after completing the file transmission, the message, 'Delete Hardware' appears on the screen.

- the message.

# ► HOW TO NAVIGATE-FILE SEARCH





Press the key, [M], somewhat short while the power is on.
While the stored files in the MP3 player are being displayed, navigate the desired file by rolling the key, [VOL/SEL], to the left/right.
When you find out a desired file to play, press the key, [POWER/PLAY], in order to play the sound file.

After setting the 'Navigation' mode by pressing the 'Menu' button on the screen short, search a desired file while rolling the key, [VOL/SEL], to the right or left.

Play the selected sound file by pressing the key, [POWER/PLAY].

While the power is on, press the menu button on the screen by using the key, [M], somewhat longer.

## ► STAGES UNDER MENU MODE OPERATION



While the power is on, press the menu button on the screen by using the key, [M], somewhat longer.



When the "Menu" mode is shown on the screen, navigate the desired menu by rolling the key, [VOL/SEL]. When the desired menu appears on the screen, press the middle of the key, [VOL/SEL], somewhat short to select the menu.

1. Select Files

Use the menu when you try to delete some files among the stored files.

4. FM Radio



Use the menu when you try to select "FM Radio" mode.
