Precautions

For safety We recommend you should AVOID :

1. Putting the MP3 player under direct sunlight or near heat (e.g. around a heater);
2. Putting metallic or flammable foreign substances into the MP3 player;
3. Disassembling or remodeling the MP3 player randomly;
4. Leaving the MP3 player in a damp/dusty/sooty place for long seconds (This may lead to failure);
5. Spreading/pouring water directly on the MP3 player in cleaning it;
6. Dropping the MP3 player or give a severe shock to it;
7. Putting the MP3 player around magnetic materials or on a vibrating site;
8. Putting the MP3 player on a site with high humidity and/or fluctuating temperature; and,

Button Type	Button Image	Descriptions
Shift Button		Push to short -> Shift location, Shift menu
OK Button		Push to short -> Select a menu Push to long -> Convert from the MP3 mode to the FM Radio mode
Navigatation Button		Push to short -> Convert from the navigation file mode Push to long -> Convert to menu mode
Power Button (POWER)		Push to short -> Power On, Play a song/Play stop Push to long -> Power Off
Record Button (REC)		Push to short -> Pause/Continue recording Push to long -> Start/Complete recording
Volume Button (ESC)		Push to short -> Volume up/down while playing. Return to the previous mode from the menu mode, Cancel a selection
Hold Button (HOLD)		To get all and every operation "locked" push this button up following the arrow direction.
Reset Button (RESET)		To initialize the MP3 player, push this button seen on the rear side with a thin tool. Please use this button in case of an abnormal operation.

Insert the driver CD		Put the Installer CD into the CD-ROM drive. ※ Windows 98 or lower version cannot identify USB devices, you need to complete the driver installation for the MP3 player.
Open to Installation File		With the CD inserted, double-click My Computer on the screen. On the next screen, double-click the CD-ROM drive.
Install the driver(1)		Double-click the "Install" file icon.
Install the driver (2)		The installation process gets started.



5. How to send a file from the PC to the MP3 Player

Check the removable disk		Double-click My Computer on Desktop to check the new removable disk(Storage). Double-click it to open the Explorer window.
Copy MP3 and common type files		Open a folder containing MP3 files in the computer and select a file(s) to get the file sent to the removable disk. ※ One folder can hold up to 999 files in it.
Copy MP3 and common type files		If the edge of the blue MENU button(on the MP3 player) shows blinking blue light, this means data is being sent. DO NOT disconnect the MP3 player from the PC during the time. If so, the MP3 player may work abnormally, with the data lost.








Disconnect the MP3 player from the computer		<p>After the transfer, click the icon in right on Desktop to see a message "Remove hardware" Click on the message, and the MP3 player will be safely removed from the PC.</p> <p>(As for Windows98, when the file transfer is completed, the MP3 player will be disconnected from the PC with no removal process)</p>
The screen appears after the disconnection		<p>When you unplug the USB cable after the file transmission, the following screen will be displayed on the LCD display of the MP3 player.</p>
The disconnection is completed		<p>When the USB connection is released, the power will automatically turn on, going into the initial screen if the STOP mode.</p> <p>When you press the POWER ON/OFF button, a file will be played.</p>

 - Is it charged? Please get it charged.
 - Is the HOLD button of the MP3 player pushed to ON? (If so, please push the button on OFF)
 - Push the RESET button with a pin (at the back part of the MP3 player)
2. The MP3 player remains mute or makes noises.
 - Is the volume set to zero?
 - Is the connection state if the earphone normal. or is the earphone port clear?
(Foreign substances on the port may bring about noises.)
 - The earphone may be faulty.
 - Damaged data can cause noises or broken sounds. Please check with another MP3 file.
 - You may need to delete data or format the MP3 player connected to the PC.
 - Please check : Our MP3 player can play ant files in MP3 format only (Not available for Net sync function)
3. I can't download a file.
 - Please check if the USB cable is connected right between the PC and the MP3 player.
(How to check : Normal, if the display screen will show USB.)
4. The LCD screen of the MP3 player refuses to work.
 - Please get the MP3 player charged or press the RESET button with a pin.
5. The MP3 player abruptly turns off while playing.
 - Please reset the SLEEP TIME to OFF.
6. I can't make a USB connection.
 - Please see the FAQs in the customer support service in our homepage.
7. I can't get radio frequency.
 - Please set the Rx sensitivity to LOW.
 - If you set the frequency, be sure to connect the earphone (the earphone works as antenna).
8. Do not delete VOICE/FM/LINE-IN folder (basically provided folder)
 - MP3 player may not work.
9. Though USB is connected. it says that it is the unknown device.
 - Separate the MP3 from the computer and enter the device manager.
