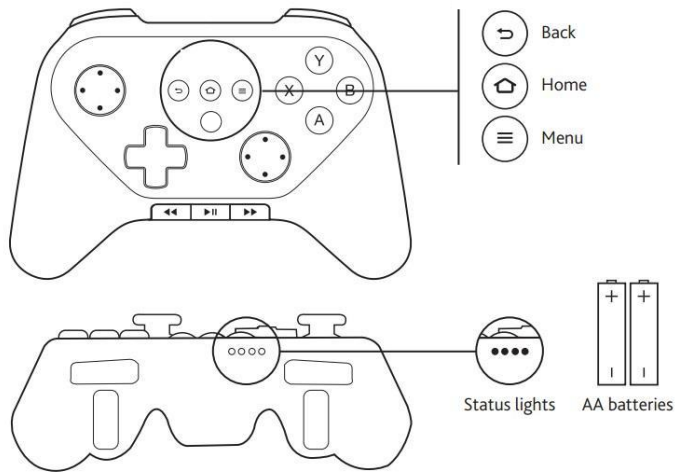


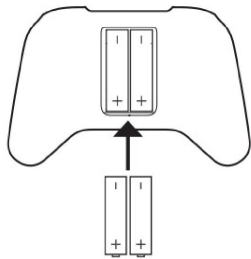

Game Controller

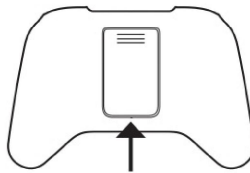
What's in the box



Insert batteries to power on



Remove the battery compartment cover and insert the batteries*. Be sure to orient the positive (+) and negative (-) ends as shown on the compartment labels.



Replace the compartment cover. The status lights blink to indicate the controller is ready for pairing with another device.

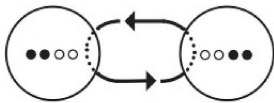
*Always use new 1.5V alkaline batteries or 1.2V NiMH rechargeable batteries.

Connect to your Device

On the controller

Hold down the Home
⊖ button for 5 seconds.

The status lights turn on, alternating between the two on the left and the two on the right to indicate the controller is ready to pair.

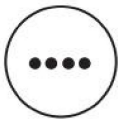


On the device

Tap Bluetooth and confirm it's enabled. Follow the onscreen instructions to scan for devices. Select game controller when it appears in the device list.

On the controller

When all four status lights are on, the devices are successfully paired.



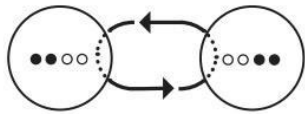
The status lights remain on for 6 seconds.

Connect to your Device

On the controller

Hold down the Home
⓪ button for 5 seconds.

The status lights turn on, alternating between the two on the left and the two on the right to indicate the controller is ready to pair.

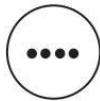


On the Device

Open Settings and select Controllers > Bluetooth Controllers. Select Add New Controller and choose Brand game controller from the list of devices.

On the controller

When all four status lights are on, the devices are successfully paired.



The status lights remain on for 6 seconds.
