







## Operating steps


1. How to connect the Antenna and power adapter to receiver.




2. How to connect video and audio cable to TV or monitor.




3. If we need receive image with computer only, just connect receiver and computer with USB cable, do not plug AV cable and power adapter.




4. Manual Channel mode: set the dip switch "L" to upward side, 1-4 to downward side, receiver set to Manual channel mode, press the channel button, the channel will switch from 1 to 4, led show the current channel.



5. Loop Mode: set the dip switch "L" and 1-4 to downward side, the receiver set to Loop mode, the receiver will auto switch channels every 5 second from channel 1 to channel 4.



6.Pairing: Press the pairing button on the receiver, channel LED flashing, then press the pairing button on the camera, receiver led stop flashing, pairing success, monitor will display the image from camera.
