

Connecting a Newton PDA to your Macintosh


There are two ways to connect your Newton to a Macintosh:

- Using a serial cable
- Using a LocalTalk network (LocalTalk connection is more complex but faster than serial communication)
 Both procedures are explained in the next few pages.

Using a serial cable

- 1 Plug one end of the serial cable into the communication port on your Newton.

 Use the cable that came with this manual.
- **2** Plug the other end of the serial cable into the printer port (\blacksquare) or the modem port (\triangleleft) on your Macintosh.





Important: If you connect Newton to a PowerBook that has an internal modem, you may need to open the PowerBook or PowerBook Setup control panel and select the External Modem button before you can complete the connection.
