USB Drag & Drop

You can transfer your pictures, videos, music, story books from your computer to your CruzTM Reader's memory card or internal storage.

- With a memory card inserted, connect a mini USB data cable from your CruzTM Reader's mini USB port to a USB port on your computer.
- On your computer, locate and click on the "Removable Disk" icon to access the tablet's memory card or internal storage.
- Drag & drop your pictures, music, videos, story books to either the CruzTM Reader's internal storage or memory card. Note: You can store the files either in the root directory or create appropriately named folders for categorization.
- When you're done, select the "Safely Remove Hardware" feature on your computer.

Safety, Regulatory & Legal

Battery Use & Safety

Important: Handle and store batteries properly to avoid injury or damage.

Most battery issues arise from improper handling of batteries, and particularly from the continued use of damaged batteries.

DON'Ts

• **Don't disassemble, crush, puncture, shred, or otherwise attempt to change the form of your battery.**

• **Don't let the tablet or battery come in contact with water.**

Avoid leaving your tablet in your car in high temperatures.

Avoid charging your Cruz Reader at temperatures below 0°C (32°F) or above 45°F (113°F).

Dos

Do avoid dropping the battery or phone.

Dropping these items, especially on a hard surface, can potentially cause damage.

Do contact your service provider or Velocity Micro if your phone or battery has been damaged from dropping or high temperatures.

Batteries and Chargers
