## 1 Download app

To easily configure and manage uRouter with 'BHU WiFi' app, please scan QR code in Wechat or search 'BHU WiFi' in app Store to download 'BHU WiFi' app.



## 2 Installation

### Power on

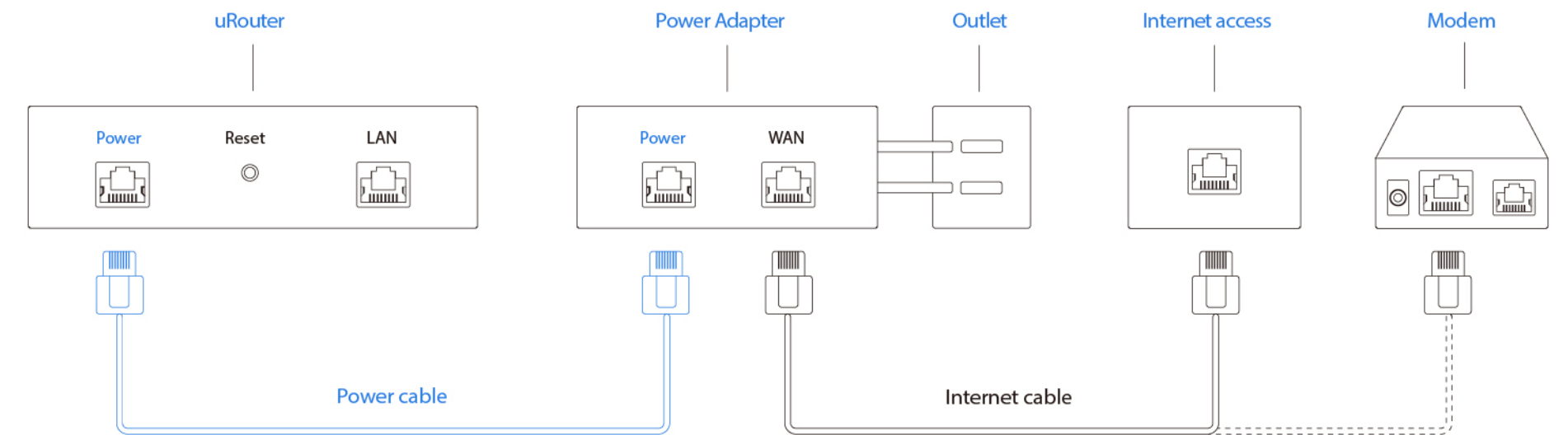
Connect power cable from blue power port on uRouter to blue power port on power adapter. And plug in.

### Connect internet cable

Connect internet cable from WAN port on Adapter to internet access (or moden)

### Check the internet indicator on uRouter.

- red ..... starting
- altering red and blue ..... internet connection broken
- blue ..... online



## 3 Connect uRouter

Use your mobile phone to search and connect to WLAN 'BhuWiFi-0' while internet indicator is altering red and blue.



## 4 Set up uRouter

Open brower on your phone. Input line.

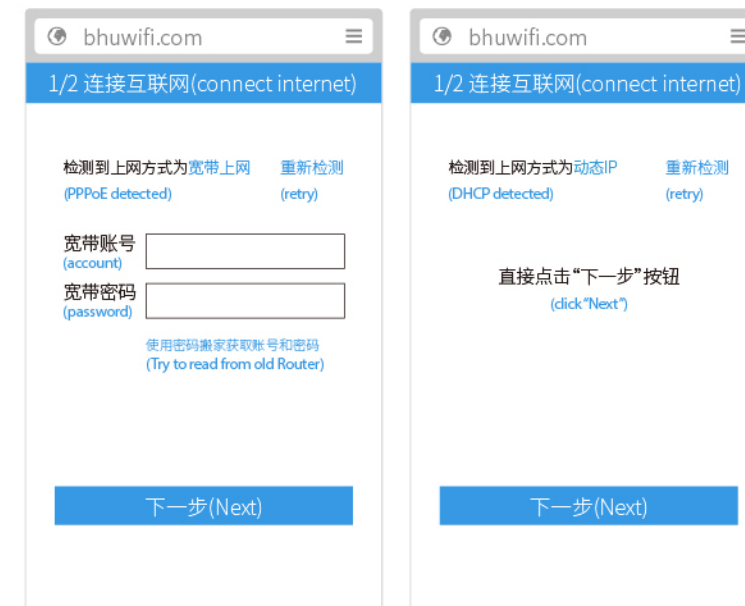
bhuwifi.com or 192.168.62.1

Open brower on your phone. Input 'bhuwifi.com' or '192.168.62.1' in address line.

1: Click 'Start'.



2: uRouter will automatically detect PPPoE or DHCP connection.



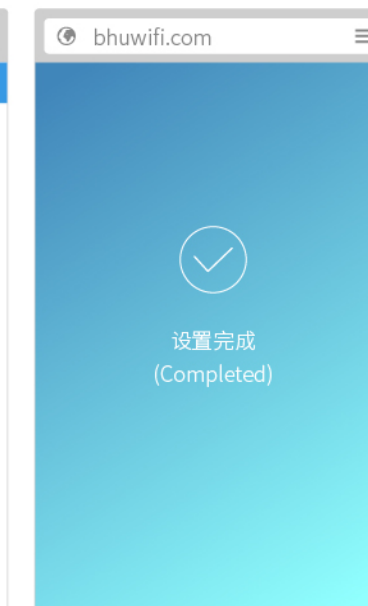
Please input your account name and password if PPPoE detected.

Simply click 'Next' when DHCP detected.

3: Name your WLAN and set a password.



Congratulations! You are connected to internet now.



5: Register your uRouter



Open 'BHU WiFi' app to register your uRouter. And manage it anytime anywhere.
