POWER ON/OFF - HOLD COMMAND

BLINKING RED - LOW BATTERY














The antenna, keypad, display, rechargeable battery and battery charger, if included, are similarly warranted for twelve (12) months from date of purchase. This Warranty is not transferable or assignable. This Warranty does not apply to:

- (a) Product subjected to abnormal use or conditions, accident, mishandling, neglect, unauthorized alteration, misuse, improper installation or repair or improper storage;
- **(b)** Product whose mechanical serial number or electronic serial number has been removed, altered or defaced;
