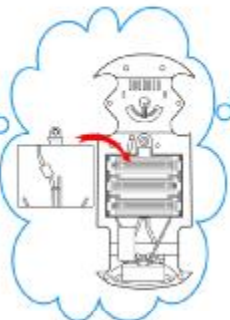

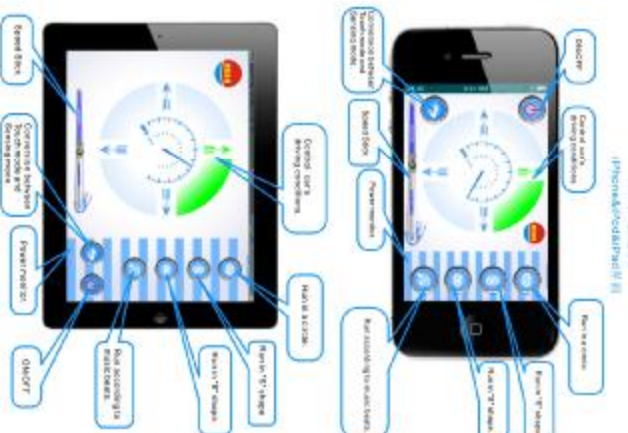
Quick Guide

Step A.
Download the software named minicar to your iPod/iPhone/iPad from app store, then install it.



- Step B.**
- Battery installation:**
1. First please make sure the power is OFF.
 2. Loosen the screws on the battery cover with a cross-screwdriver, then open the battery cover.
 3. Put three "AA" batteries in the battery box according to the direction of "+", "-" and "+".
 4. Cover the battery cover, and screw down the screws.
 5. Moved power switch from OFF to ON.
