- Windows98 needs only its driver. But do not necessary to install driver under Windows2000 and XP.

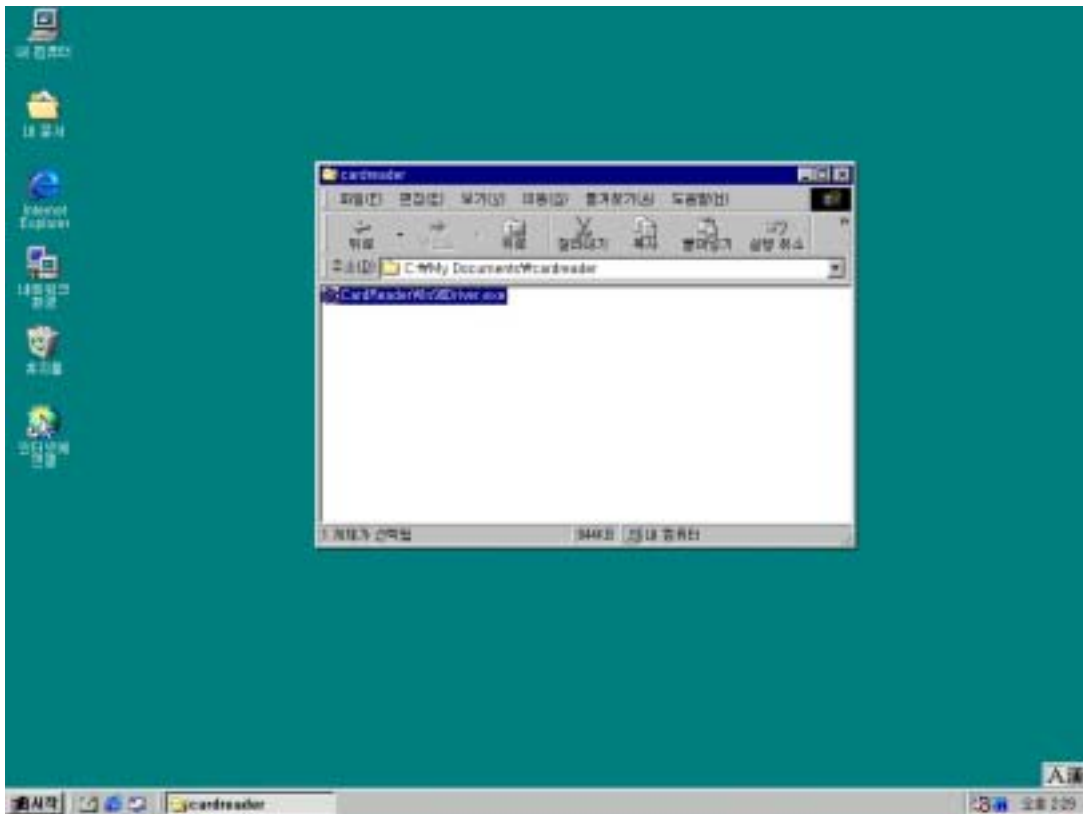
How to install Driver)

Windows 98/Windows Me

Supplied CD contains files named CardReaderWin98Driver.exe. This is the s/w

for Card reader being operate.

First STEP)



Double click CardReaderWin98Driver.exe>

Second STEP)



Install to this folder or different folder, click browser and another folder.

C:\Program Files\CardRaderWindows98 is the default folder to be stored set up file. Click **NEXT>**

Third STEP)



After installation completed you can see the window the installation completion.
Click OK> and then connect Card Reader to USB port.

Trouble Shooting)

Symptom	Cause/Check	Cure
Fail to realize device	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Check USB port and connector's condition. If it connected firmly.2. Driver install completion.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Disconnect and connect again.- Delete drive and reinstall properly.
Not working driver	Flash card connection	Reconnect.
