## **Speaker Placement**

Your Portable Beatbox<sup>™</sup> is designed and engineered to sound great anywhere you place it. However, realizing that every space is different, there are placements that will maximize the performance of your Beatbox<sup>™</sup>. The home environment can present a challenge in choosing the best location for your Beatbox<sup>™</sup>. The trick is to place the Beatbox<sup>™</sup> in a location that will take advantage of the acoustic properties of your room and give you the best overall balance of sound.

Distance to the side walls, back wall and corners can have the biggest impact on the sound of your Beatbox $^{\mathbb{W}}$ . The closer the Beatbox $^{\mathbb{W}}$  is to a wall, floor, or ceiling the more bass reinforcement you will get. Maximum bass comes when it's placed in a corner.

The shape of Beatbox™ allows you to place it perfectly into a corner, giving you a great combo of space saving and deep bass. The surface you place your Beatbox™ on can also significantly impact the sound. Make sure you place your Beatbox™ on a solid surface to avoid unwanted distortion to the sound.

The height of your Beatbox™ in relation to your listening position can also affect the sound quality. Ideally, your Beatbox™ should be as close to ear level as possible and at least four feet away from your listening position for the best performance.

We encourage you to spend the time to experiment with the location of your Beatbox™. Trial and error is the best way to hear how your Beatbox™ reacts in your environment. Take your time to find the ideal location to ensure you experience the best sound quality your Beatbox™ has to offer.


