

Hardware Installation

- polarity signs in the batteries of the keyboard is installed collectly. Please follow the polarity signs in the battery compartment.


 2. Please make sure the slide switch on the top right of the keyboard is switched to "on" before using the keyboard. When not in use, please turn the power switch to "off" for power saving.
