





1. Working indicator light

When the power is turned on, the white light is on: When the power is turned off, the white light is off; When charging, the red light is on

2. Power switch/sound switch button

Long press for 2 seconds to turn on or off the power.

When the device is on, short press to switch the sound effect. For

each short press, the sound effect is shifted as follows: Orginal mode → Super reverb mode → Pop music mode → Country

music mode → Folk music mode → Speech mode → Anime mode

→ Monster mode → Music playback mode.

Factory default to Wonderful Singer Sound. 3. Button for two singers

Long press for 2 seconds to turn on/off duet mode.


4. Bluetooth reset button

Long press for 3 seconds to disconnect the connection between the microphone and the Bluetooth.




- Long press the power switch for 2 seconds, the white indicator light is on, and the device is started successfully;
- Connect your phone to Bluetooth. Turn on Bluetooth and search for device. Click "CALF Speaker Microphone QS" to connect.
 Adjust the power switch/sound switch button to switch different
- sound effects, experience different singing effects until you want the sound mode;
- 4. Open a Music/Live/Video APP and start the wireless singing tour.

Special instructions:

- The digital audio DSP used by the microphone will remember the sound mode, and the reboot sound mode will be the state before the shutdown.
- 2. Wireless singing mode does not support Bluetooth recording.
- It is recommended to adjust the sound effects in the meeting hosting environment as follows: Host Sound.

Wireless Singing Mode for Two Singers



- Open the power switch of the two microphones, and long press the Bluetooth reset button of the microphone to disconnect the Bluetooth connection between the microphone and other devices;
- 2. Long press the button of Wireless Singing Mode for Two Singers of one microphone for 2 seconds, and the work indicator light will flash quickly. When two microphones prompt the sound: "duet mode on" at the same time, it means that the two microphones are successfully paired;"
- Turn on the Bluetooth of the mobile phone, search for "CALF Speaker Microphone Q5" and click to connect to Bluetooth;
- Open a Music/Live/Video APP, and adjust the phone volume, microphone sound mode to the appropriate state;
- Begin a duet of two singers.


Special instructions:

- The Wireless Singing Mode for Two Singers requires two microphones, and it does not support the pairing of more than two devices.
- After the two microphones are successfully paired, either one of the microphones will be switched off or Bluetooth reset to terminate the pairing state. If you need to re-pair, please repeat the above steps;
- Bluetooth recording is not supported in of Wireless Singing Mode for Two Singers.



- Long press the power switch for 2 seconds, the white indicator light is on, and the device is started successfully;
- Connect your phone to Bluetooth. Turn on Bluetooth and search for device. Click "CALF Speaker Microphone Q5" to connect;
- Adjust the power switch/sound switch button until it enters the "Music playback mode";
- 4. Open a Music/Live/Video APP, and play music.

Cable recording mode



- Connect the microphone with the mobile phone through the audio line and insert the earphone;
- Long press the power switch for 2 seconds, the white indicator light is on, and the device is started successfully;
- Open a Music/Live/Video APP, adjust the phone volume and microphone sound mode to the appropriate state, and experience different recording effects;
- 4. Start recording.

Special instructions:

In wire recording mode, the microphone's playback function will be turned off automatically. Microphone prompts or musical accompaniment can be heard in the headphone monitor.

SUPPLEMENT ENERGY



- Can be connected to the mobile power supply, computer USB port or power adapter for charging;
- 2. During charging, the red indicator light is always on;
- Charging completed, the red indicator light is off.

Remark:

When charging, turn on the power switch and the white indicator light will be lit. It is recommended to charge in the power off state.

Special instructions:

- When the power of the microphone is less than 5%, the red indicator flashes, indicating that the power is low. At the same time, you can hear the voice prompt of low power.
- Do not charge in the environment below zero, charging below zero may cause battery damage;
- Please use a power adapter to charge. The following type of power adapter is recommended: 5V 1A.
