


## Introduction

The MyMed-Reminder simply converts a "dumb" pill box or "dumb" pill vial to a "smart pill box" or "smart" pill vial. The MyMed-Reminder can remind individuals to take their medication on time, record medication history, help address the issue of forgetting or missing daily medication and notify others if the medication was taken or missed. It is suitable for home and travel use, and can be connected to smartphones or other smart electronic devices via Bluetooth. By using the MyMed Reminder app, users can access their medication records and it can also help caregivers monitor the medication situation of the user.



- ★ 1 Buzzer beep sounds
- ★ 2 Silicone button/LED light

### Performance Features Include:

- ★ Compact and portable, easy to operate
- ★ APP with one-click location finder to prevent loss
- ★ Automatically generate medication records
- ★ Supports notification of guardians by email

## Battery Replace

- 1 Insert a coin or another tool into the groove on the battery cover, turn counter clockwise to remove it.
- 2 Take out the old battery and insert a new button cell battery, making sure the negative terminal is facing inward.
- 3 Close the battery cover, turn clockwise with a coin or other tool, and lock the battery cover tightly. Once the battery is successfully installed, the device will automatically power on.

### First Use

Before the first use, you need to open the battery cover and remove the insulation film. The factory status flashes green, indicating that the device is not paired.


### Low Battery Reminder

When the battery is low, the device blinks red for 30 seconds every 10 minutes. Replace the battery.

## Reminder Steps

1. Set medication information: Input the medication name, and medication time in the app.
2. Attach the device: Stick the MyMed Reminder to a commonly visible location, such as your current pill box or pill vial.
3. Connect the device: Use bluetooth to connect the MyMed Reminder to a smartphone or other smart devices.
4. Customize Reminder Alerts on the MyMed-Reminder and your phone.
5. Confirm medication: The user presses the silicone button on the MyMed-Reminder to confirms medication taken.

## Medication Reminder



It's time to take the medicine!

The light flashes and the drip sounds intermittently.

### Reminder Description

1. The medication schedule is transferred to the MyMed-Reminder via bluetooth and saved in its memory.
2. When it is time to take the medication, the yellow light flashes, and the buzzer beeps at the same frequency for 30 seconds. There will be 3 reminders, 10 minutes apart, for 1/2 an hour.
3. Press the button to stop the flashing yellow light and the buzzer reminder. The system recognizes that the drug has been taken. A green light stays on for 1 second and then turns off.
4. If the button is not pressed within the 30 minute period, the beep will stop but the yellow light will be stay on for another 30 seconds. The system will record a "missed" dosage.
5. The MyMed-Reminder will transmit the "Taken or "Missed" to the APP via Bluetooth. Users can open the third-party sharing function through the APP to share the medication "Taken" or "Missed" status to a third party and to themselves by email.

## Maintenance & Storage

Please keep the device in a cool, dry, and clean place, away from direct sunlight.

## Factory Reset

Press and hold for 3S and then quickly press 3 times to reset factory data, after reset successfully, the green, yellow, and red lights are each on for 1S and accompanied by the buzzer ringing 3 times, then the factory reset will delete the original pairing information to allow the device to be paired again, and will delete all medication plans and medication records.

## Set up APP Medication Plan

### 1 Download & install the MyMed Reminder app

Available in the app stores "MyMed Reminder" or scan the QR code to download and install the app, and follow the on-screen prompts to fill in the required information for registration and login in!




### 2 MyMed Reminder connect to APP

2. Once logged in, navigate to the device or settings section of the app.




### 3 Login Account and Connect Device

Note: Please keep your phone's Bluetooth on!




### 5 History Record

1. History of a medication. If you took your medication at a different time than scheduled, then you can adjust a medication record accordingly.



### 6 Set Device

1. Click "Customize Reminder" to display a customized notification page that can be selected in four modes.




3. Click on "Today's Reminder Settings", choose a medication to adjust (delay or advance) only today's upcoming reminders.




### 8 Profile

You can click "Profile" to change the password and other personal information.




### 4 Set Reminder


In the main interface, click "Upcoming" to schedule the medications. Set the reminder time, such as 12:00 AM, medication name, frequency, etc.



2. The history records can be viewed separately as annual reports, monthly reports, and weekly records. Click the Share icon in the top right corner to forward the report to a third party.




2. Click on "Find Device" and the device will be located via Bluetooth. The device will beep until you press "Stop Beeping".
