Introduction:


Before using your BOOMBUDS earphones for the first time, please take a few moments to read through the user manual.

In the box:

2 x BOOMBUDS ear pieces.
1x BOOMBUDS charging carry case
1x Charging USB micro to USB cable.
2 x wing tip sizes x 2 colours
3 x Sets of silicone ear tips
1x manual.

fitting:

To ensure the best sound please choose from the 2 wingtips & 3 ear tip sizes. To change size gently remove and then simply replace.



Boompods Tip:


The tighter the fit in the ear the better the sound will be.

Controls:

On/Off - press & hold MFB for approximately 3-4 seconds Play - press MFB once Pause - press MFB once To skip song forward - press MFB twice quickly To skip song backward - press MFB three times quickly Siri - press hold MFB for 2 seconds.

Calls:

To take a call quickly - press the MFB once. To reject a call - press and hold MFB for approximately 1-2 seconds To end call, short press MFB



To turn off simply place into the charging case, or press either of the multi-function buttons until you hear "GOODBYE" or the light has turned red.

Pairing & Bluetooth connection:

- 1. Remove your Boombuds from the case, press and hold the multi-function buttons for approximately 3 seconds, or until you see the lights go red, if you have them in your ears when you do this a voice will prompt; "HELLO", "CONNECTED" this means they are now connected to each other and ready to pair to your Bluetooth device.
- 2. Now open your Bluetooth device menu and look for the words BOOMBUDS in the menu, select this then you will be prompted "PAIRED" the light will now flash slowly green, you are now connected and ready to play music and receive calls. Some devices will automatically request to be paired as soon as you have switched on your Boombuds and open Bluetooth device menu, simply select "Pair".
- Once paired to your Bluetooth device next time you use your BOOMBUDS it will remember and all you need to do is press both MFB for no more than 3 seconds & they will automatically pair to each other and the Bluetooth device.
- 4. If you want to pair to a new Bluetooth device you will need to remove from the old device and start the pairing sequence again with the new device.

Charging:

- 1. Before using for the first time please fully charge the case with supplied USB cable, insert the micro USB end to the case (1) and the USB end (3) to your USB socket. This will only take approximately 2hrs. When fully charged 4 blue LEDs (4) will be lit.
- To charge ear pieces insert into the case this will take approximately 40mins, the light will be RED whilst charging and turn GREEN once charged.
