

# **FUNCTIONS** Long press 2S: Power on/off. Short press 2 times: Bluetooth disconnected, Short press 3 times: Reset factory data,



Long press 25S: Reset Bluetooth speaker, hort press: Switch LED mode, Long press 2S: Turn off LED light, Short press 2 times: TWS connection; TWS disconnection, Rotating to left: Volume -, Rotating to right: Volume +,

Short tap 1 time: Pause/play music; Pick up/hang up call, Short tap 3 times: Previous song, Short tap 2 times: Next song/phone call private protection, Long tap 2S: Reject call, Long tap 4S: Switch EQ mode,


# **OPERATIONS**

#### 1. Power on/off

Long press " ()" button for 2S to power on, long press it for 2S again to power off.

### 2. Bluetooth mode

It will enter to Bluetooth mode after power on, and the blue indicator will flash. Then choose "SoundRoll" from your devices list. You will hear a voice prompt once it is connected, and the blue indicator will stay on. Then you can start to play your music. Short press "O" button two times to disconnect Bluetooth connection. Short press three times to delete speaker's Bluetooth connection history information. When the speaker shut down, long press "O" for 25S to reset it, then long press "O" for 2S can power on the speaker.





# 3. TWS Connection

1) Power on two "SoundRoll" speakers, they will enter to Bluetooth mode. 2) Short press each of their " M "button twice, two speakers will enter to TWS pairing mode and you will hear a voice prompt once they connected successfully. The master speaker's blue indicator will keep flashing, the sub-master speaker's blue

indicator will stay on. 3) Choose "SoundRoll" from your device list to connect the master speaker. You will hear a voice prompt once it connected, and the blue indicator will stay on. After the two models successfully connected with your phone, you can play music on both of them at the same time.



### 4. Volume control

Rotating the volume control knob to right to increase volume, and left to decrease volume. There will be a "di~di" sound when the volume is adjusted to the maximum. • Previous/next track control

Tapping status indicator area 2 times for next track and 3 times for previous track under Bluetooth mode


Control under playing status

Tapping 1 time to play/pause music under Bluetooth mode; Tapping 1 time to mute/unmute under AUX mode.

# 5. Handsfree call

When you have a incoming call, speaker will enter into handsfree mode automatically under Bluetooth connected status. Short tap status indicator area once to answer the call and short tap it again to hang up. Short tap the area twice to transfer the call from speaker to phone which can protect your privacy.



#### 6. AUX mode

This speaker supports AUX music playing. It will turn into AUX playing mode automatically once you insert AUX cable.

# 7. LED lighting mode

This speaker supports 10 different LED lights. Short press " M " once to switch to another light. (mode 1, mode 2, mode 3, mode 4, mode 5, mode 6, mode 7, mode 8, mode 10-off these 10 modes will loop) Mode 1 is defaulted mode when you power on.

# 8. EO mode

This speaker supports balance sound, pure sound and bass sound three different FO modes. Long tap status indicator area 3 seconds to switch to another EQ. Balance sound is defaulted when you power on.



# 9. Battery saving

Speaker will power off automatically to save battery when there is no any device connected in 10 minutes. Long press " O " 2S to power on again.

# 10. Charging/power supply

- Do not use the adapter which has no any safety certificate
- Suggest to use output 5V/2A(or above) adapter to charge 1. Please charge it as soon as possible when you heard low battery voice prompt
- 2. Red indicator will be on while charging and it will be off when charging done



## **FUNCTION INSTRUCTIONS**



Power on	Blue indicator will be on when power on, and enter to Bluetooth mode automatically, then the blue indicator will flash quickly (in Bluetooth searching status)
AUX	Green indicator will on when you insert AUX cable
Bluetooth status	Blue indicator stays on when Bluetooth is connected
	Bluetooth indicator keeps flashing when your Bluetooth device is out of range or disconnected, then the speaker will be in searching status.
Maximum volume	There will be a voice prompt when you rotate the speaker's volume to the maximum.
Charging status	Red indicator will be on while charging and be off when charging done.
Low battery	Red indicator flashes when battery is low.
LED lighting	Mode 1 is defaulted when power on. There are 10 different modes.

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

# Q1: What kind of charger should we use for the speaker?

A: All common USB chargers can be used, while we suggest the ones 5V/2A or above

# Q2: What if there is noise or discontinuous sound during playing?

A: The speaker can be normally used within 10m under no obstruction environment. If it is beyond 10m or with obstruction, there might be noise or discontinuous sound.

# disconnection? A: When there is no bluetooth pairing in 10 minutes, the speaker will shut down

automatically to reduce power consumption.

Q3: Why the speaker power off automatically after power on but no Bluetooth

# O4: Why does the speaker cannot connect the once-paired cellphone? A: First, remove the speaker's paired name from the cellphone's Bluetooth List and

then restart pairing.

# Q5: The speaker cannot be started up in a normal situation.

A: Please plug in the charger and try in a few minutes or try to long press power button 10-30s to reset.
