

Operation Guide

1. Bluetooth Mode

Turn on the power switch "Ⓞ". The bluetooth light glows, and the speaker will automatically enter into pairing mode. Now you can find the bluetooth name "Chili Speaker" in your mobile phone or other bluetooth device. You can play the music now.

2. TF Card Mode

When insert the TF card, the speaker will change to TF card mode automatically.

3. USB Mode

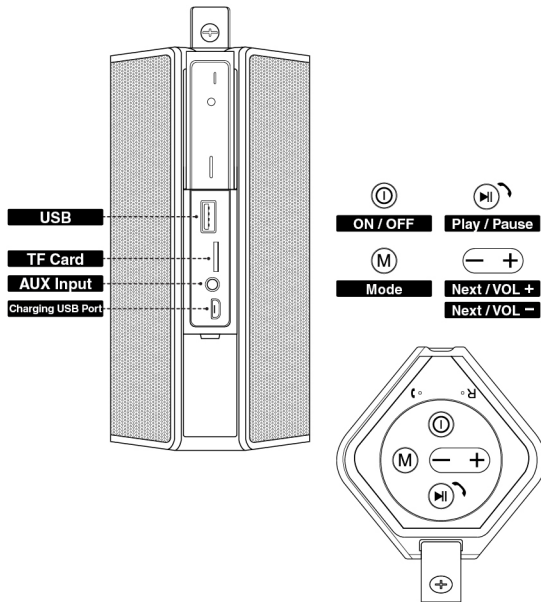
When insert the USB flash drive, the speaker will change to USB mode automatically .

4. Aux Input Mode

Connect 3.5mm audio cable with the speaker, the speaker will change to AUX mode automatically.

5. FM Mode

Connect 3.5mm audio cable with the speaker, then press the "Ⓜ" button for FM mode, at this time, the audio cable can be used as Antenna.
