

BATTERY INSTALLATION

Insert 4 "AA" size (UM-3) batteries into battery compartment. Is sure the correct battery polarity indicated inside the battery compartment. For best performance and longer operating time, we recommended the use of Alkaline Batteries.

BATTERY PRECAUTIONS

Follow these precautions when using batteries in this device:

1. Use only the size and type of batteries specified.
2. Be sure to follow the correct polarity when installing the batteries as indicated next to the battery compartment. Reversed batteries may cause damage to the device.
3. Do not mix different types of batteries together (e.g. Alkaline, Carbon-zinc and rechargeable) or old batteries with fresh ones.
4. If the device is not to be used for a long period of time, remove the batteries to prevent damage or injury from possible battery leakage.
5. Do not try to recharge batteries not intended to be recharged; they can overheat and rupture. (Follow battery manufacturer's directions.)
6. Clean the battery contacts and also those of the device prior to battery installation.
7. Remove used batteries promptly.

RADIO OPERATION

1. Slide the POWER ON/OFF switch to "ON" to turn on the radio.
2. Set the Band selecting switch to AM, FM or WB.
3. Turn the dial to select the desired station, and adjust VOLUME control to desire level.
4. To listen privately, insert the headphone plug (not included) into the Headphone Jack.
5. To turn off the radio, slide the POWER ON/OFF switch to the "OFF" position.

ANTENNA

1. For AM reception radio is built-in a highly sensitive Ferrite core bar antenna, adjust the unit direction for best reception.
2. For FM reception, pull out the telescopic antenna fully and position it for the best reception by adjusting the length and direction.

STATION FOR WB BAND

A very important service available on the weather band is the broadcast of local weather conditions and forecasts. This service is a new service provided 24 hours per day under U.S. Government supervision by the United States Department of Commerce, Environmental Services. The new service is available simply by tuning the dial pointer to (162.55 MHz) on the weather band dial scale.
