CHARGING THE BATTERY

Charge the battery before first use. A full charge takes approximately 1.5 hours. After charging, the device can be used without the power connection. When the battery is low, the LED indicator flashes red once per minute.

If the device is not used for an extended period of time, the battery may require recharging.

To charge the battery:

- 1. Plug the USB connector into a USB port on an active device.
- Plug the Micro USB end of the USB connector into the Micro USB port on the earbuds. The LED light turns red during charging. The light turns blue when the earbuds are fully charged.

PAIRING WITH BLUETOOTH®

- Prepare your device (e.g., smartphone) to pair using Bluetooth[®], making sure that the device is within 33 feet of the earbuds. Refer to your device's owner's manual for information on using the Bluetooth[®] function.
- Press and hold the earbud's Multi-Function Button (MFB)for about 4 seconds, until the LED alternates between red and blue, indicating that the earbuds are in pairing mode.
- 3. On your device, search the list of available devices and select Big Blue Earbuds. Note that it may take a few seconds for the earbuds to be listed as an available device. Depending on your device, you may have to tap SCAN to update the device list. Consult your device's owner's manual.
- 4. If prompted, type the password or PIN 0000.

A message will display on your device confirming that your device is now paired/connected and the earbud's LED will flash blue three times quickly, indicating that the device is paired.

The devices will remain paired, even after being turned off, until you cancel the pairing. Consult your device's owner's manual for information on cancelling pairing.
