During Operation

- The transmitter has a range of approximately 26 feet (8m), outdoors. Do not drive the car outside this distance or control of the car will be lost.

- Do not touch moving parts during operation.
- When you have finished driving your car, turn the power "OFF" on your car, then turn the controller "OFF".
- Remove the battery from the car controller when not in use.

- Never store your car near water, outdoors or in the rain.
- Immediately switch off your car and transmitter if you see lightning or hear thunder.
- Ideally, store your car in the box in which it was supplied.




REMOTE CONTROL KEVIN'S CAR OPERATION/CONTROL INSTRUCTIONS

SETTING UP YOUR R/C CAR

1 INSTALLING 9V DRY CELL BATTERY INTO YOUR TRANSMITTER (BATTERY NOT INCLUDED)

- Ensure the transmitter power is turned to "OFF".
- Use a screwdriver (not included) to remove the screw which holds the battery cover.
- Insert the rear end of the 9V battery in first. Make sure it is facing in the right direction by matching the polarity symbols.
- Replace the battery cover and reinsert screw.

NOTE: WHEN LED LIGHT ON THE
TRANSMITTER BECOMES DARK,
PLEASE CHANGE TO NEW BATTERY.




2 INSTALLING AA DRY CELL BATTERIES IN YOUR CAR (BATTERY NOT INCLUDED)

- Ensure that the power switch of the car is "OFF".
- Open the battery cover by slightly pushing and sliding down the battery cover toward the back of the car.
- Insert 4 x AA batteries into battery compartment. Make sure each battery matches polarity marks inside the battery compartment.
- Close and slide the battery cover back into position.

! CAUTION:
Keep batteries away from children.
Batteries may be harmful if swallowed.
Requires 1 9V and 4 AA batteries. Batteries not included.

HOW TO CONTROL/OPERATE YOUR CAR

FORWARD BACKWARD




- Turn the power on both car and the controller to "ON"
- To move forward, press the left button on the right hand top of the controller.
- To move backward, press the right button on the right hand top of the controller.
