


Charge your Li-Po battery


- 1. Slide the power switch to OFF. Unscrew the battery cover.
- Insert six AA alkaline batteries(notincluded) matching the polarity symbols (+and -)marked inside. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screws.
- Slidethe power switch to ON. Both the red and green lightsurnon.
- Inserthe Li-Po battery matching the polaritmarks as shown. The green light starts toblink.
- The green light stops blinking once the battery is fully charged. DC 9V Remove the battery and turn off the charger

Note: You also can choose a DC 9V 300mA AC adapter (not included) to power the charger,



Install Batteries

- 1. Turnoffthe carand controller.
- Insertone 9V battery pack (notsupplied) in the controller's battery compartment matching the polarity (+and -) marked inside.
- 3. Lift the upper carbody.
- 4. Unscrew the batterycover of the chassis and connect a fully charged Li-Po battery pack OR two AAA alkaline batteries (not supplied) matching the polarity marks inside.The battery only fits



Compartment (with Li-Po battery pack installed)


5. Replace the carbody, battery door and tighten the screw.

- Battery Notes:
 - Use only fresh batteries of the required size and type. Do not mix old and new batteries, different types of batteries (standard, alkaline, or rechargeable), or rechargeable batteries of different capacities.
 - Dispose of batteries promptly and properly. Do not burn or bury them. If you do not plan to use the vehicle for a long time, remove the batteries from both the vehicle and controller.
 - Thoroughly check the charger and Li-Po battery before charging. Li-Po battery included in the package needs to be charged before using for the first time. Remove the battery after charging.
- Use battery and charger enclosed in the package only as it is specially designed to use for flipz racer & truck.
- Once the red light of the charger turns off, change to fresh AA
- Always charge the battery under adult supervision.
- Allow the battery to cool down before recharging.
- Do not charge your battery under direct sunlight, heated, humid places or inside the vehicle.
- Do not dismantle or solder the charger nor the battery.
- If your charger or Li-Po battery is extremely hot, smoking, expands, smells or the green light doesn't blink, turn off your charger and remove the battery.






- 1. Screw the antenna firmly into the controller's antenna hole.
- Align the frontside of the bottom carbody to match the rearside of the chassis (location of the power switch).
 Snap fastenerthe carbody into the magnet holders of the chassis. The bottom carbody should match with the upper carbody reversely.

4 Drive the Car

- 1. Turn on the controller and the car.
- 2. Use the controller's levers to steer your car.
- 3. Turn off the controller and the car when you finish driving.
 - To play spin and flip function, you need to power your car with the supplied Li-Po battery pack.
 - Power indicator will turn dim when battery power goes lower. Once it does, install fresh battery.
