





HOW TO CONTROL YOUR VEHICLE

WITH CLAWS CLOSED AND LOCKED
By closing all 4 claws, you can enjoy fast and exciting action.

1) Make sure power switches of both the vehicle and controller are turned to "off."

2) Push in the wheel lock of each wheel until it makes a clicking sound.






3) Turn the power switch on both controller and the vehicle to "on."



TROUBLE SHOOTING		
CONDITION	CAUSE	SOLUTION
VEHICLE DOES NOT MOVE	No Battery in vehicle or controller.	For vehicle, re-charge your battery pack. For controller, install new battery.
	Batteries not installed correctly in vehicle or controller.	Re-install the batteries.
	Batteries in the vehicle or controller are weak.	For vehicle, remove your battery pack and re-charge it. For controller install new battery.
	Power Switch on the vehicle or controller is "OFF."	Turn the power switch "ON."
VEHICLE IS OUT OF CONTROL	Batteries in the vehicle or controller are weak.	Change all batteries to new ones.
	Influenced by other controller or device with same frequency.	Find another place to play or keep a distance from the other device that is interfering with your vehicle.
CLAW DOES NOT OPEN	Sand or dust or dirt might be inside the joint of the tire mechanism.	Manually open the mutating tire several times until sand or dust gets out of the joint part of the tire mechanism.
9.6 NI-MH BATTERY PACK WEARS OUT EASILY	Battery Pack may not be fully charged.	Recharge your Battery Pack.
	Battery Pack may be at end of its life cycle.	If the Battery Pack cannot reach its full potential even after fully recharging, it may be at the end of its life cycle. Please buy new 9.6V Ni-MH Battery Pack.
