OVERVIEW

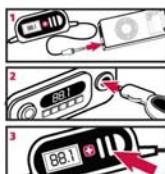
This SwissGear by WENGER GA-6210-15 Universal FM Transmitter allows you to connect your iPod wirelessly to your car stereo. This device uses the auto adapter for power and is correctly connected when the LED indicator is illuminated. Select a station on your car stereo and simply select the same station on the transmitters LCD display, press play and start enjoying your music library out loud!



INSTALLATION

Connecting to the iPod:

1. Plug the Car Stereo FM Transmitter connector into your iPod. (1)
2. Plug the Car Stereo FM Transmitter power adapter into your car's 12V accessory outlet. (2)
3. Choose your station by pressing one of the 3 preset memory buttons (3) (see **Setting "Favorite Station" Preset Buttons**).

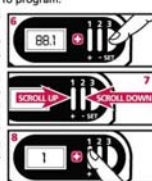


4. Tune your FM radio to the same channel as indicated on the Transmitter LED. (4)
5. Press the "Play" button on your iPod. (5)
6. Use your car radio's or iPod's volume knob to adjust sound level.



Setting "Favorite Station" Preset buttons:
FM Transmitter features 3 programmable "Favorite Station" memory presets. Left (1+), Middle (2) & Right (3 Set). Select stations on your car stereo that are "quietest," i.e. the most free of strong radio station signals. These may change depending on where you are. To program:

1. Press and hold button 3 (Set) for 1 second. (6)
2. Press buttons 1 or 2 to scroll and select stations up or down. (7)
3. Select station, press & hold any button for 1 second to set memory. Confirmation will display as 1, 2 or 3. (8)
4. Press buttons to recall your preset stations. Set more stations by repeating steps 1 through 3.



Note: While in "station selection" mode, if station is not set within 10 seconds, device automatically reverts to "Preset" memory mode, temporarily keeping your present station.

IMPORTANT

- Experiment and select the channel that offers the least interference and the clearest sound.
- Select a channel not occupied by a strong local FM radio station.
- Due to antennae locations, certain cars may have difficulty receiving clear signals.
- Vehicles with windows containing a metallic film may have difficulty receiving clear signals.
- Momentary interference may occur due to signal bounce around buildings or hills.
- Steel structures may act as an antenna, strengthening or weakening a signal. You may have better reception when you are away from the structure.

FOR YOUR SAFETY: Connect your Wireless FM Transmitter BEFORE operating the vehicle.
