- 3-1 Remove the cap before use.



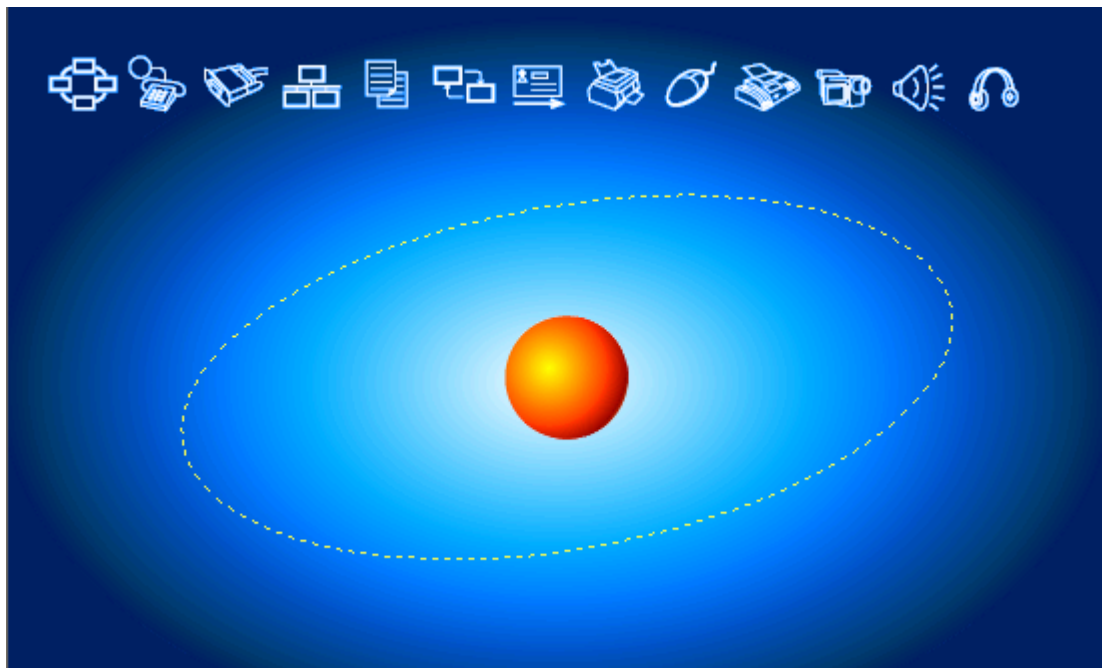
- 3-2 Directly plug into an available USB port.

4. Pairing

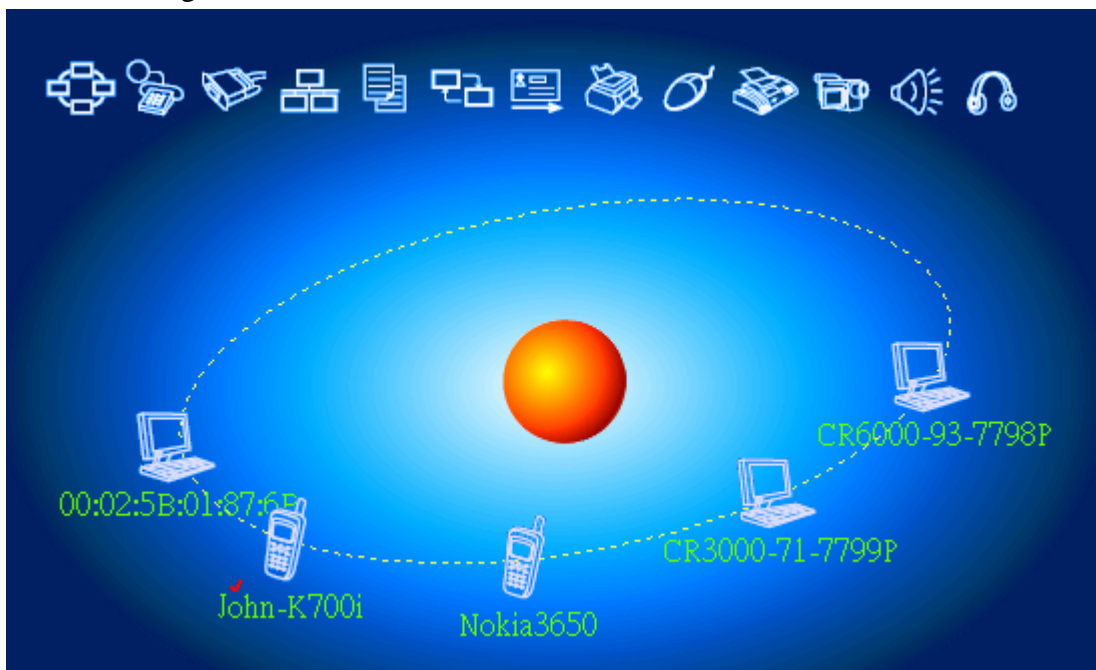
4-1 Double-click the "BlueSoleil" on your desktop.


