## WIRELESS SPEAKER

Thank you for purchasing this Billboard® Wireless Speaker. For best use of this device we recommend carefully reading this user manual and keeping it for your records.

#### PACKAGE CONTAINS

- a. Wireless Speaker
- b. USB charging cable
- c. Remote control
- d. 3.5 mm AUX cable







#### POWER ON/OFF

- Rotate the Volume knob clockwise until it clicks.
- The unit will enter into Bluetooth mode.

#### CHARGING BATTERY

- Charge the speaker battery fully before using.
- Connect the Micro USB Charging cable (included) to the front of the unit and USB to USB Adaptor (not included) to an AC Power outlet
- Charge Battery Time about 5-6 hours in Power Off mode
- In Charging mode, the indicator light will show red and when complete charged the light will be off.

#### PAIRING YOUR SPEAKER

Pairing your Bluetooth™ speaker is like starting a relationship with it. Once paired. the speaker will automatically connect to your device the next time they are both powered on, and in proxminity to each other.

- Power on your speaker. The screen will read BT to indicate Bluetooth™ mode.
- 2. On your Bluetooth™ enabled device, navigate to the Bluetooth™ settings panel. The speaker will appear as BB-BT-SP, select that name to connect. Most devices will not ask for a password, but if one is requested, use 0000.
- 3. Once the speaker has connected successfully, you will hear a sound announcement

#### CONNECT USING AUX


- Plug in a 3.5mm audio cable into the AUX input, just below the LED indicator light, on the speaker control panel.
- You can connect to any audio device that has 3.5mm audio input jack and can playback any audio from this device.
- Note: You will not be able to use the speaker control panel buttons or remote control to control playback with this option.


#### LISTENING FROM USB/TF

- Plug in your USB stick or SD card in the appropriate slot on the front.
- Your speaker will automatically begin playback music from your memory card.
- You can use the control panel or remote control with your USB or SD card.

#### OPERATIONS DURING PLAYBACK

- To raise or lower the volume, rotate the Volume knob.
- To raise or lower the treble, rotate the Treble knob.
- To Pause/Play, short press the button.
- To advance to the next track, short press the button.
- To restart the current track, short press the button.
- To navigate to the previous track, double short press the button.


