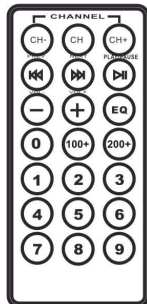




FM Transmitter with LCD USER GUIDE

REMOTE INSTRUCTION

- 1) When you plug in your USB Flash drive or SD Card it will list your songs in order of the upload to your device, it will also associate a track number to the song. To go to a song, just press the track number associated with the song.
(Example: To go to the #135 song press the number "1", "3", "5", The FM transmitter screen will flash the track number and song name)
- 2) Press the CH+ or CH- to change the frequency or press a frequency number then press CH
(Example: To go to FM frequency 107.5 press the numbers "1" "0" "7" "5" The screen will flash the FM frequency.)
- 3) To change the volume on the remote press the - to decrease or + to increase the volume.
- 4) Press the EQ button to change the mode of the transmitter from: NORMAL, POP, ROCK, BASS, CLASSICAL, LIVE etc.
- 5) Press to Play/ Pause your music.
- 6) Press the "PLAY/ PAUSE" button of remote control about 2 seconds, 4 kinds play mode for "A, S, F, 1" were changed on FM transmitter screen for user to choose which play mode to be.

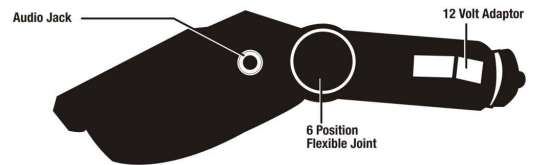
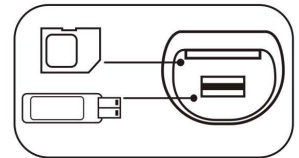
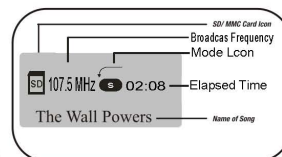

Congratulations on purchasing the FM Transmitter
Follow these easy steps to get started

SD/ MMC CARD & USB FLASH DISK

- 1) Insert the SD/MMC Card into the SD/MMC Card slot of transmitter
Insert the USB Flash Drive in USB Port of transmitter
Insert the audio device in the audio jack of transmitter
- 2) The LCD will display the screen shown in Fig. 4 press the button once to start playing an MP3 file.
Press again to pause.
- 3) Press the button once to advance to the next file. Press and hold the button to increase the volume.
- 4) Press the button once to go to the previous file. Press and hold the button to decrease the volume.



Previous Track & Volume Decrease
(USB FLASH DISK & SD/MMC CARD)
Press this button once to return to the previous file. Press and hold to decrease the volume.

Next Track & Volume Increase
(USB FLASH DISK & SD/MMC CARD)
Press this button once to advance to the next file. Press and hold to increase the volume.

Play/Pause/Shutdown
(USB FLASH DISK & SD/MMC CARD)
Press this button once to start playing an MP3 file. Press it again to pause.

Channel Button
(USB FLASH DISK & SD/MMC CARD)
Press the channel button to change the broadcasting frequency. The transmitter remembers the last broadcast frequency.
