3. OPERATION:

- 1) CLIP THE VOICE PICKER OF THE CONVERTER CORRECTLY TO THE SPEAKER OF THE CELLPHONE, THEN TURN ON THE RADIO IN THE CAR AND SET IT TO FM88.7MHZ.
- 2) WHEN CALL COMING, THE EK-2000B/C WILL TURN ON AUTOMATICALLY WITH THE LED ON AND THE POWER WILL TURN OFF WITHIN 10 SECONDS AFTER THE CALL IS OVER.
- 3) WHEN THE EK-2000C IS POWERLESS AND THE LED TURNS RED DURING WORKING TIME, PLEASE CHARGE YOUR BATTERY. WHEN CHARGING THE BATTERY, PLEASE PLUG THE BATTERY CHARGER INTO THE CIGARETTE LIGHTER AND CONNECTS THE ADAPTOR OR THE CHARGER TO THE CORRESPONDENT SOCKET IN THE CONVERTER., THEN THE LED TURNS ON AND AFTER FINISHING CHARGING, THE LED TURNS OFF.

4. NOTES:

1) WHEN THE SIGNAL OF THE CELLPHONE IS WEAK, IT WILL EFFECT THE PERFORMANCE OF THE COMMUNICATION.

- 2) WHEN USING THE CONVERTER, PLEASE PUT THE CELLPHONE IN A SUITABLE PLACE, WHERE IT WILL NOT INTERFERE THE WORKING OF THE STEREO.
- 3) WHEN THERE IS SOME BUZZ AND THE LED TURNS WEAK, THAT INDICATES THE POWER IS OUT AND PLEASE CHANGE THE BATTERY OR CHARGE IT.
- 4) TO ADJUST THE VOLUM TO BE LOUDER, PLEASE ADJUST THE VOLUME OF THE CELLPHONE FIRST AND THEN THE CAR STEREO'S. BY DOING SO, IT CAN IMPROVE THE PERFORMANCE OF THE COMMUNICATION AND AVOID THE ECHO.
