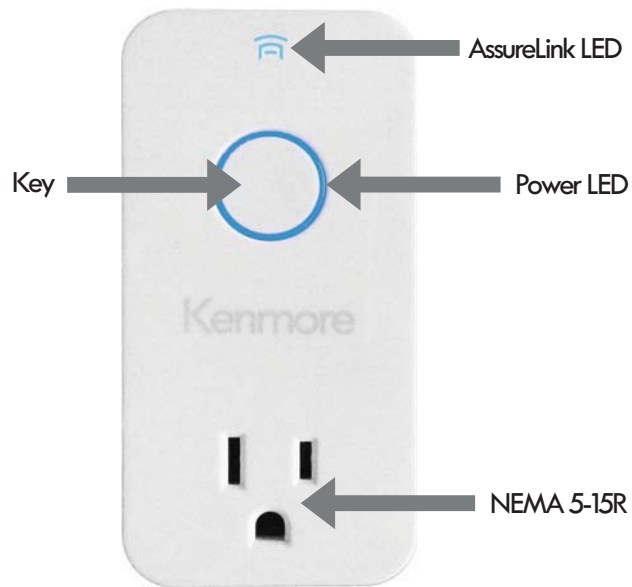

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using your equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons, including the following:

2. This device must be installed and used in strict accordance with the installation manual and/or use and care guide.
3. Comply with all warning and caution statements in the instructions.
4. Only connect the Smart Plug to a 120V AC power source with circuit breaker or over current protection device.
5. Do not install this Smart Plug at an altitude of over 6500 feet (2000 meters).
6. The Smart Plug should only be used in dry and clean environment. Do not place the unit in bathroom or other area with excessive moisture.
7. This device should not be used in an environment that is below 14°F (-10°C) and above 104°F (40°C), humidity above 80%.
8. Do not connect the Smart Plug to voltage fluctuations of more than 10%.
9. Clean the Smart Plug with a dry, soft cloth. Do not use solvents or aggressive cleaning agents. NEVER use detergents, gasoline, glass cleaner, furniture polish, paint thinner, or other household solvents to clean any part of the Smart Plug.
10. This device is designed for household usage only, not suitable for commercial and industrial use.
11. If there are any malfunctions appeared during the operation of the Smart Plug, switch off the mains and unplug the Smart Plug in safety situation.

KEY	FUNCTION
Key	When Network is not available, Press and Hold the Key for 5 seconds will allow the Smartplug to seek for WPS enable router for 2 minutes. When Network is available, Press and Hold the Key for 5 seconds will remove all paired network information. Press the key 5 times within 10 seconds will request the cloud to do a factory reset.
AssureLink LED	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The assurelink LED will turn ON, when successful connected to Cloud • The assurelink LED will turn OFF, when connection to Cloud failed. • The LED will flash slowly, when the Smartplug is seeking for WPS enabled router.
Power LED	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The LED will turn ON, when power output from Plug. • The LED will turn OFF, when no power output from Plug.

FEATURES / OPERATION

Power on the Plug

Plug the Smartplug into 120V AC outlet.

The AssureLink LED will turn ON for 1/2 seconds, then

Both LED will turn OFF for about 15 seconds, then

The Power LED and AssureLink LED will turn On and OFF alternatively for 2 seconds, and then user can operate the Plug.

The AssureLink LED will turn On after short while, if WiFi connection to router is successful.

Quick Change of Power Output

To Toggle the Power output, press and release the key.

Connect the Plug to router and cloud

Press and hold the key for 5 seconds until the AssureLink LED is flashing.

Push the WPS key of your router.

Wait for the AssureLink LED stop flashing and turn ON.

CLEANING / MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

Assurelink smartplug provides electricity control and monitoring for your appliances system. It can also be controlled through your mobile smart phone or website remotely. After installation, the smartplug doesn't need any special handling or attention.

In order to maintain the accuracy of the smartplug, you have to clean it regularly. Don't use any chemical or detergent to clean the smartplug. Just use the wet cloth with water to clean the surface and also the air vent once a month is good enough to maintain the smartplug working properly.
