WELCOME

Thank you for purchasing the Bluetrek headset. Before using this product, please charge your headset for 1.5 hours and read the safety and quick start guide carefully.

CHARGING

When you hear a low-tone beep in your headset at regular intervals, and the indicator light flashes in red, your headset needs to be recharged.

- 1 Charging Socket
- 2 The indicator light turns red when the battery is charging. When fully charged, the indicator light will change to blue.

Pay attention to the plug direction

Page 1

SWITCHING ON/OFF

- 1 On/Off switch button

Thanks for ultra low latency technology, you can switch on the headset when call arriving to prevent accidental headset operation.

ADJUSTING VOLUME

- 2 VOL Button

Tap the volume button once for each volume increment. After reaching the max volume, tapping again will drop the volume to the lowest setting.

Page 2

PAIRING

Press the TALK Button for approx. 5 seconds until blue and red light flashes.

Once the mobile phone detects the headset, a "BLUETREK CARBON" message will be displayed.

Page 3

Follow the phone instructions to accept the pairing. The PIN code (or passkey) is 0000, then press "yes" or "ok".

If your phone supports Secure Simple Pairing (SSP), you will not need to enter a PIN code.

For some phones, you may need to select "Connect".

Page 4

FITTING ERGOBUD® ADVANCE

The earbud can be rotated on speaker to better fit the contours of your ear.

If the earpiece feels unstable, change the earbud to a different size.

WEARING

Thanks for light and balance design, ear hook is unnecessary, just for extra security.

Page 5

REMOVABLE PEN CLIP

Clip it on to clothes or whatever you can attach to when not in use. Rotate the clip in suitable position for convenience.

MAKING CALLS

Dial the number on the phone keypad or use voice recognition if your phone is equipped with this function.

ANSWERING/ENDING CALL

- 1 Press Once on the TALK Button

ANSWER A CALL DURING CHARGING

If the headset is powered on: Press once on Talk Button;

If the headset is powered off: Switch on the headset, it will answer the call automatically.

MULTI-POINT FUNCTION

Multipoint technology which allows to use one headset with two Bluetooth enabled devices. Please see the instructions as below:

Enable the multi-point function

1. Pair the headset to the 1st device (Please refer to "pairing" section).
2. Press and hold the TALK button for about 5 seconds (press once if first time use) to enter into pairing mode, then pair it to the 2nd device. (Please refer to "pairing" section).
3. Press once on the TALK button again. The 2 mobiles will be connected automatically.

Answer a call while talking on the other paired phone

- To answer the second call and put the current call on hold, double press the TALK button to swap.
- To answer the second call and terminate current call, press once on the TALK button.
- To reject the second call from mobile phone directly.

MUTING THE MICROPHONE

To mute the microphone during an active call

During an active call, press and hold the VOL button for approximately 2 seconds. A periodic tone can be heard in the speaker when the microphone is muted.

To end the mute function

When the microphone is muted, press and hold the VOL button for approximately 2 seconds. The periodic tone will end.

VOICE ALERT

A recorded voice reminds you of the actions in your headset, such as: low battery on headset, low battery on phone (this features are phone / laptop dependent), redial the last number, mute, unmute etc...

You can select the language from first switch on the headset. Press TALK button accordingly the instruction (defaulted in English). 3 languages are available for this headset : English, Mandarin and Spanish. If you want to change the language in the future, you will need to reset your headset. See "Reset" section.

BATTERY STATUS ON iPhone™

Pair the headset to your iPhone™. The headset battery meter will display in the status bar of your iPhone™.

RESET

When the headset is in idle or stand-by mode, press the TALK and VOL button for about 5 seconds until you see the red LED indicator. After 7 seconds, the headset will be switched on automatically.

The volume level of the Bluetooth® headset may vary, depending on your mobile phone. Before using your headset for the first time, adjust the headset volume to the lowest, then increase the volume gradually until you reach to an acceptable level. High levels of volume may result in hearing loss, avoid using the headset at high volume continuously. If you experience ringing in your ears or muffled speech, consult your doctor immediately and stop using the headset. Check local laws regarding use of a mobile phone and earpiece while driving. If you use the earpiece while driving ensure your attention and focus remain on driving safely. For better performances, avoid the microphone touching your jaw or face. The face will absorb some of the transmission output power and reduce the range. It also leads to possible noise in audio. Use hook or not to have the microphone 1cm from your jaw. 	<p>Charge warnings</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For your first time use, please charge your headset for 3-4 hrs until the red indicator light turns off. To maximize battery lifetime, it is recommended to recharge your headset to full capacity only when the battery is low, since a battery has a life time of about 350 charging cycles. If you leave your headset battery empty for an extended period of time, it could excessively discharge the battery. In this case, charge your headset for 3 hours or more until the battery recovers and recharges completely. When you first charge the headset after prolonged storage, it may take few minutes for the red indicator light to turn on. It is recommended to full charge your headset before you store it for long periods of time without use. Your headset is fully charged, the red indicator light will not turn on when plugging into the charger. Do not over charge your headset for more than 10 hours. The use of any other charger will automatically suspend the warranty. It is forbidden and can be dangerous. Ensure that the voltage rating corresponds to the local mains or power supply you intend to use. Optimal handling may not always be practical in real life. Deviations from the ideal are acceptable but will lower the life expectancy of the battery to some degree.
