


Before using your BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC for the first time, you must charge it continuously for approximately 3 hours, until the indicator change to green. Please refer to the "Charging the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC" section of this manual.

#### Introduction

The BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC is a wireless car kit based on Bluetooth® technology. It complies with Bluetooth® 2.0 protocol, supporting Headset and Handsfree profile.

### Using the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC in different environment

**Mounting on the sun visor as a car kit**When using your BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC in your car, simply mount the unit onto the visor with the clip as shown in Diagram 1.






For best voice reception, please adjust the rotary microphone arm around 45 degree, or other position suits you most

## Charging the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC

Connect the charging cable to the car charger and insert the car charger into the cigarette lighter socket as shown in Diagram 2.

You can also connect the charging cable to a USB socket.



While charging, the indicator light on the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC should be orange. The green indicator light will turn on when the unit is fully charged. Subsequent charges should take approximately 3 hours.

When the indicator light on your BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC flashes in red at regular intervals (or the voice alert is activated), the unit needs to be recharged.

#### Important:



- · If your BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC is fully charged, the green indicator light will turn on when plugged into the charger.
- To maximize battery life time, you should recharge your BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC to full capacity only when the battery is low, because the battery has a life time of approximately 350 charging cycles.
- · It is recommended to full charge your BLUETREK $^{\circ}$  COMPACT CLASSIC before you store it for long periods of time without use.
- If you leave your BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC on with battery empty for an extended period of time, it is recommended that you and charges it for 3 hours or more until it is completely recharged. When you first charge the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC after prolonged storage, the orange indicator light might not turn on until after a few minutes.
- $\cdot$  Do not charge your BLUETREK  $^{\circ}$  COMPACT CLASSIC for more than 10 hours.
- The use of any other charger will automatically void the warranty, it is strictly forbidden and can be unsafe.

#### Pairing the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC

Before using the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC, you must pair it with your Bluetooth® mobile phone. Pairing is the process of linking 2 Bluetooth® devices, so that they can communicate.

English

#### To initiate pairing:

- Place the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC and your mobile phone within 0.3 meter (1 foot) from each other.
- Switch on your phone and select its Bluetooth® discover mode (refer to the Bluetooth® mobile phone user manual).
- When the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC is switched on, press and hold both
  the TALK button and the VOL+ button for about 5 seconds until the indicator light
  flashes red and blue alternately. And a sound can be heard in the speaker.
- Once the mobile phone detects the carkit, a "BLUETREK COMPACT CLASSIC" message will be displayed. Follow the phone instructions to accept the pairing. The PIN code (or passkey) is 0000, then press "yes" or "ok".

If pairing was successful, the indicator light will switch to blue.

If you haven't started the discovery mode within 5 minutes, it will stop. In this case, you must start the pairing again as step 3 above.

## Switching the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC ON and OFF

English

#### Switching the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC ON

Switch on the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC by lifting up the microphone arm as shown in Diagram 4. You will hear a beep (2 tones) in the speaker (and continuous connecting beeps until it is connected to the handset). During about 5 seconds, you can see the blue LED blinking until the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC is switched on. Once the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC is switched on, you can see the blue LED keeps lighting.

#### Switching the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC OFF

Switch off the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC as shown in Diagram 5.

#### Making a call

Make sure the headset is paired to your phone and in range, dial the number on the phone keypad and press call.

#### For mobile phone with voice recognition\*

- . Make sure the voice recognition function on your mobile is activated and your voice tags have been recorded with the phone. To enter these, please refer to your phone's manual.
- . When there is no incoming or active call, press once on the TALK button
- . Wait for the audio signal sent by the mobile phone (generally a short tone).
- . Speak the name of person you wish to call.

#### Answering a call

#### When your BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC is OFF

Switch on your BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC. After about 3 seconds, It will automatically transfer the call from the phone to the car kit. For some phones, you may need to press "Connect" on the phone.

#### When your BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC is ON

Press once on the TALK button to take the call.

#### Ending a call



Press once on the TALK button to end an active call.

#### Adjusting the volume

To increase the volume during an active call, press the "VOL+" button on the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC.

To decrease the volume during an active call, press the "VOL-" button on the BLUETREK COMPACT CLASSIC.

#### Muting the microphone

#### To mute the microphone during an active call

During an active call, press and hold the VOL+ or VOL- button for approximately 2 seconds. A periodic tone can be heard in the speaker when the microphone is muted. You can still adjust the speaker volume by pressing shortly on the VOL+ or VOl- button.

#### To end the mute function

When the microphone is muted, press and hold the VOL+ or VOL- button for approximately 2 seconds. The periodic tone will end.

#### **Ending a call**

## Muting the microphone

#### To mute the microphone during an active call

During an active call, press and hold the VOL+ or VOL- button for approximately 2 seconds. A periodic tone can be heard in the speaker when the microphone is muted. You can still adjust the speaker volume by pressing shortly on the VOL+ or Vol- button.

#### To end the mute function

When the microphone is muted, press and hold the VOL+ or VOL-button for approximately 2 seconds. The periodic tone will end.

#### Call waiting

English

When you hear a call waiting alert while you are on a call, press the TALK button on the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC approximately 2 seconds to accept the second call and place the current call on hold.

To switch between an active call and a held call, press the TALK button on the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC approximately 2 seconds

To end the active call and take the held call, press the TALK button once on the BLUETREK® COMPACT CLASSIC.

### Rejecting a call

Press the TALK button on your car kit for approx. 3 seconds to reject the call.

#### Redial the last number

With a phone in Headset Profile This function is not available.

With a phone in Hands-Free Profile

When there is no incoming or active call, press the TALK button on your carkit for approx. 2 seconds.

#### Important safety and operational information

Please read the following information before using the headset. Additional warnings may be present on the product, packaging or in the user manual.

#### Warnings

- Using Bluetooth headset at high volume level and noisy background can potentially cause hearing loose.
- The volume level of the Bluetooth® headset may vary, depending on your mobile phone. Before using your headset for the first time, adjust the headset volume to the lowest, then increase the volume gradually until you reach to an acceptable level.
- High levels of volume may result in hearing loss, avoid using the headset at high volume continuously. If you experience ringing in your ears or muffled speech, consult your doctor immediately and stop using the headset.
- Check local laws regarding use of a mobile phone and earpiece while driving. If you use the
  earpiece while driving ensure your attention and focus remain on driving safely.
- Observe all signs and instructions that require an electrical device or RF radio product to be switched off in designated areas, such as gas/refueling stations, hospitals, blasting areas, potentially explosive atmospheres, or aircraft.



- For optimal performance, wear your the headset and your mobile phone on the same side of your body or within line of sight and angle the headset so that it points toward your mouth.
- For better performances, avoid the microphone touching your jaw or face. The face will absorb some of the transmission output power and reduce the range. It also leads to possible noise in audio. Use hook or not to have the microphone 1cm from your jaw.



#### Charge warnings

- For your first time use, please charge your headset for 3-4 hrs until the red indicator light turns off.
- To maximize battery lifetime, it is recommended to recharge your headset to full capacity
  only when the battery is low, since a battery has a life time of about 350 charging cycles.
- If you leave your headset battery empty for an extended period of time, it could excessively
  discharge the battery. In this case, charge your headset for 3 hours or more until the battery
  recovers and recharges completely. When you first charge the headset after prolonged
  storage, it may take few minutes for the red indicator light to turn on.
- It is recommended to full charge your headset before you store it for long periods of time without use.
- If your headset is fully charged, the red indicator light will not turn on when plugging into the charger.
- Do not over charge your headset for more than 10 hours.
- The use of any other charger will automatically suspend the warranty. It is strictly forbidden and can be very dangerous.
- Ensure that the voltage rating corresponds to the local mains or power supply you intend to use.
- Optimal handling may not always be practical in real life. Deviations from the ideal are
  acceptable but will lower the life expectancy of the battery to some degree.

#### Others warnings

- · Do not drop or try to alter the shape of your headset.
- Do not expose your headset to liquid, moisture, fire, open flames and extreme temperatures.
   Operating and storage temperature is 0°C to +40°C (32°F to +104°F)
- Keep your headset away from dust and dirt.
- Do not try to disassemble your headset. Service and Maintenance can only be performed by authorized dealers.
- Do not let children play with your headset, since it contains small parts that could become
  detached and create a choking hazard. Keep all products, cords, and cables away from
  children. As with all corded products, there is a danger of strangulation if a cord should
  become wrapped around your neck.
- Install and use earbuds in accordance with the instructions provided. Do not force the speaker and earbuds down the ear canal. If either becomes lodged in the ear canal, seek medical attention immediately.
