




**BACK PANEL**

#### **Connect Power**

#### Caution:

- Risk of product damage! Ensure that the power supply voltage corresponds to the voltage printed on the back or the underside of the unit.
- · Connect the power cord to the wall outlet.

#### **Connect to External Audio Device**

Use an 3.5mm to 3.5mm audio cable to connect the external audio device (e.g. TV, iPhone...) headphone socket to the AUX socket on the unit.

**Operations** 

#### Power ON/OFF

- When you first connect the unit to the main socket, the unit will be in STANDBY mode.
- · Slide the button on the main unit to the ON position.
- · Slide again to switch the main unit back to Standby mode.

- · Be sure to unplug the power cord from the outlet when the system is not in use for an extended period of time.
- · If there is no signal under the Bluetooth and AUX mode, the unit will automatically switch off within 10 minutes.
- · When turning the system on, the system will continue in the mode it was in when it was turned off last time.

#### **Adjust Volume Level**

- Press the Volume Up/Volume Down buttons to adjust the volume.
- The display will flash once when you reach max volume.

#### Using A Bluetooth Device

#### **AUX Operations**

- Ensure that the unit is connected to the TV or audio device.
- Press Volume Up / Down to adjust the volume to yourdesired level.
- In AUX mode, operate your audio device directly for playback features.

## Pair Bluetooth-enable Devices Manually

- The first time you connect your Bluetooth device to this speaker you need to pair your device to this speaker.
- The operational range between this player and a Bluetooth device up to 30 feet.
- Before you connect a Bluetooth device to this unit, familiarize yourself with the Bluetooth capabilities of the device.
- Compatibility with all Bluetooth devices is not guaranteed.
- Any obstacle between this unit and a Bluetooth device can reduce the operational range.
- Keep this player away from any other electronic device that may cause interference.
- 1. If the device hasn't been paired with a device it will enter paring mode automatically.
- 2. Press the Bluetooth Connect button to be searchable.
- Activate your Bluetooth device and select the search mode. "Windsor" will appear on your Bluetooth device list.
- Select "Windsor" in the pairing list. If the pairing succeeds, the device will make a confirmation sound.
- To disconnect the Bluetooth function, disable the function from your Bluetooth device.

NFC Operation

#### Pairing an NFC-enabled Device

- 1. Activate NFC on your mobile device.
- Tap the mobile device on the NFC sensing area of the unit.
- Operate your mobile device directly for playback features.
- 4. To disconnect, tap the mobile device on the NFC sensing area of the unit to disconnect or disable NFC from your mobile device.

#### <u>Listen to music from Bluetooth device</u>

If the connected Bluetooth device support Advanced Audio Distribution Profile (A2DP), you can listen to the music stored on the device through the player. If the device also supports Audio Video Remote Control Profile (AVRCP), you can use the player's remote control to play music stored on the device.

- 1. Pair your device with the player.
- Start playing music via your device (if it supports A2DP).

#### Note:

- To pause/resume play, press play/ pause button on the device or use the native controls on your device.
- To skip to a track, press the track up/down buttons on device.

Hands Free Instruction

#### **Hand Free Controls**

- · First pair Bluetooth device with speaker
- When there is a call coming in, press the phone button to answer, playing music will pause; and press again to end call. Hold button for 3 seconds to refuse call. Press twice to redial numbers.
- Hold the Volume Up button to redial last dialed number
- Hold the Volume down button to mute microphone, hold again to unmute.

Trouble Shooting

#### No power

- Ensure that batteries are inserted corectly or that the AC cord of the device is connected properly.
- Ensure that there is power at the AC outlet.
- Press standby button to turn the unit on.

#### No Response From the Unit

 Disconnect and reconnect the AC power plug, then turn on the unit again, or remove and re-insert batteries.

- Ensure the Bluetooth function is activated on your Bluetooth device.
- Ensure you have paired the unit with your bluetooth device.
