## 1. Important Notices...

## 1. Important Notices...

Do not handle the product with wet hands as it may cause malfunction of the product and, especially, if the AC adapter is handled with wet hands, there is a risk of electric shock.

Use the LCD screen with a stylus pen provided by the manufacturer or a tool not pointed. Otherwise, the LCD may be damaged.

The film attached on the LCD is a film used to protect the LCD. If the product is used with the film on, accurate operation may not be achieved. Be sure to use the product after replacing the film with the LCD protection film separately provided.

When using USB cable, adapter and snap-on, be careful with the direction of connector insertion. If it is inserted the other way around, it may cause a problem for PDA or PC. Also, do not use extremely bent or pressed by heavy object cable.

The product may not properly operate in very cold winter or hot summer. The proper operating temperature is between  $-10^{\circ}\text{C} \sim 50^{\circ}\text{C}$ . Be especially careful to avoid storing the product in a place too hot or cold, or too moist. This may cause external change or product damage.

In following cases, warranty service will not provided or repairing may be impossible:

- If the product has been disassembled or remodeled by user's self;
- If the product has fallen into the water or stored in a moist place for a long period of time;
- If the product has been dropped from a high place or received excessive external shock.

Charge the battery fully for at least 30 minutes or longer before using the product for the first time. The product may not turn on before the battery is charged.



## 1. Import Notices...















Name	Description
① LCD	Touch screen on which information is displayed
② Receiver	Part used as receiver where sound is output during telephone conversation
③ Button	Buttons used to enter phone numbers, or start or terminate the call
④ Barcode Reader	Part where laser is output for bar code scanning
⑤ Camera & Flash	Camera and flash used to take pictures
⑥ Battery switch	Switch used to mount or remove the battery
⑦ Battery	Standard or large capacity battery
⑧ Barcode Scanner Button	Button used for bar code recognition
⑨ Earphone	Hole into which the earphone is inserted
⑩ Volume Increase/Decrease Button	Button used to increase / decrease the volume of telephone conversation
⑪ Strap	Part to tight user's hand with the device
⑫ Speaker	Part of the sound output
⑬ Sleep Button	Button used to turn on and off the LCD with the power on
⑭ Battery Charging Sign	Part to show the state of battery while the battery is charged
⑮ Mike	Part used as speaker where sound is input during telephone communication.

#### To Connect Power and Charge

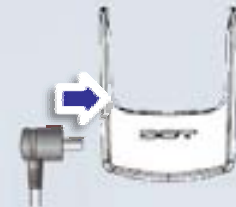

Connect the charging gender into the gender insertion hole at the bottom of the terminal.

**2**

Connect the adaptor to the power connector at the right side of the gender.

During charging, the LED at the right top of the product lights in red color and, when charging is completed, it changes to green.

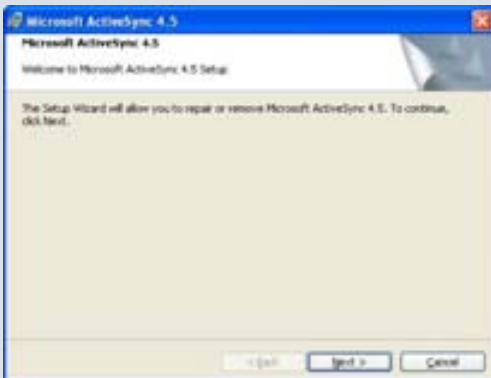
The time required for battery charging is the time calculated using an exclusive charger and the charging time and duration differ according to charging status and environment in which the product is used.

- Duration of the batter may differ according to service form of the communication provider, environment in which the product is used and the period the battery is used.
- Battery will be consumed even when the product is not used. Especially, battery is a consumable part. Purchase and use a new battery if one time duration after charging has been considerably reduced.
- While the warranty period for PDA is one year, that of the battery is six months.

#### To install Active Sync

In order to connect (synchronize) PDA with a PC, Microsoft program called ActiveSync is required. For installation, execute 'Install Program' and press 'Next'. At this time the PDA and PC should not be connected.

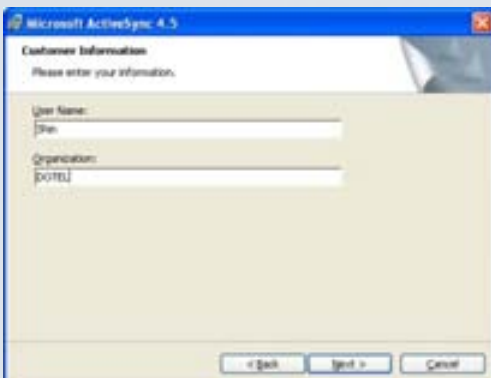

Agree with the license of Microsoft ActiveSync. Select 'Agree' and press 'Next'.



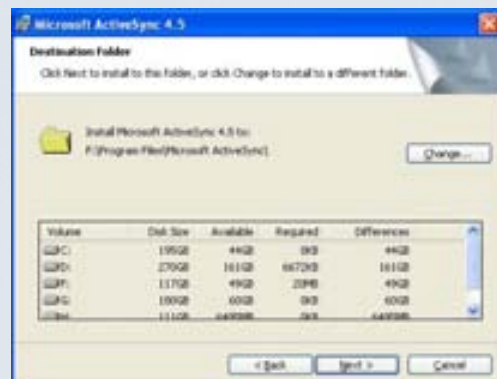

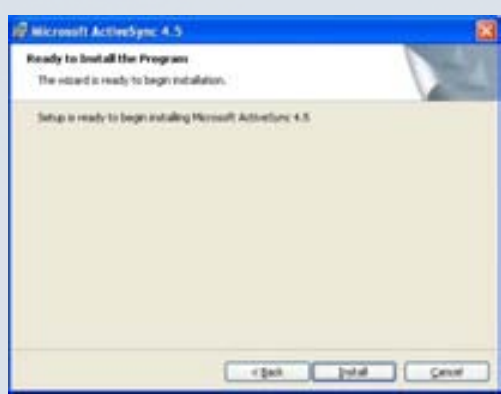
Check the disk capacity which can be used for installation and change the installation location by pressing 'Change' or press 'Next' if you want to install it in the default location.

**5** We are fully prepared for installation of ActiveSync. Execute installation by pressing 'install'.

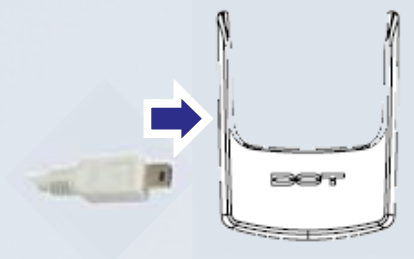


**6** Installation of ActiveSync will be performed. It may take several minutes depending on the environment of the user PC. Wait for a while.

Install Active Sync and driver as above when OS of the PC you used is Windows 2000, Windows XP.

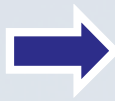
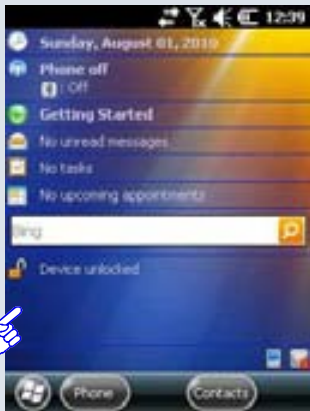
Execute Windows Mobile Device Center without installing Active Sync and Driver when OS is Windows Vista or Windows 7.

#### Setting Locking Function



The screen will be shown like the right picture after touching Device Unlocked on standby screen. Closing the function can be closed by touch sliding. The PIN number box is displayed after touch sliding if the PIN number is set.

#### Tasks

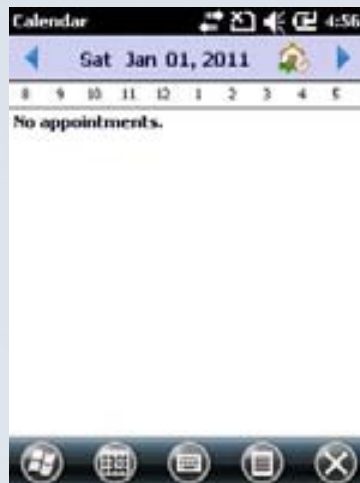
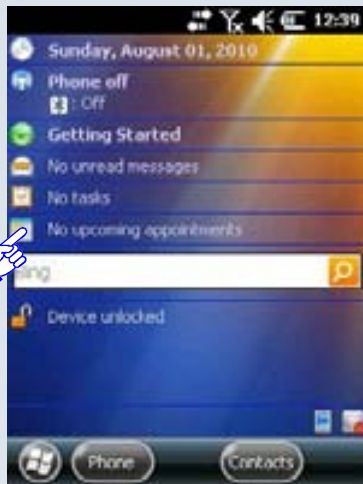


Tasks is the function of managing ongoing work or task. It supports the efficient work process by prioritizing the tasks.
